How to leave discord server as owner

Comments Share If you're ready to leave your server, but still want someone to take a good care of it, you can transfer their ownership to someone else. **WARNING:** Be careful when transferring server ownership. And finally, hover over the desired user's name & click on the three dots to open a sub-menu where you can click Transfer Ownership. And there you go! After you log on, open server settings. Under User Management, click on the tab 'Members' tab. [Source: Discord] Wait for pop-ups to make sure you want to transfer ownership. Then click the Transfer Ownership button to verify. If a verification code arrives, either go to your email or go to your 2FA code and enter the given code. After completing the transfer you will still be a member of the server. The access you retain depends on the permissions associated with your role. Joining a Discord server can be a great way to meet people who share your interests. However, if the conversation is not what you expect, or if you are just not vibing with the server for some other reason, you have the option to leave that server. Leaving a Discord server removes your name from its member list, and disables any role you held on the server. You also do not receive any more messages or messages from the server. The only exception to this is if you are the owner of the server – in this case, you must transfer ownership of the server before you leave. Here's how to leave a Discord server with the Desktop app for Mac and PC or the mobile app for iPhone and Android devices. You will be able to join a server you left again at any time. Select the three-point menu to the right of the member you want to transfer ownership of the server as well, then select Transfer Ownership. When prompted to tick the box to confirm your selection, select Transfer Ownership. The member you selected is now the owner of the server and can do with it whatever they desire.
