DEWALT DWE402 4.5 Angle Grinder - Best Overall DeWalt DWE402 is an impressively powerful 11-amp grinder that will be able to navigate both high volume and precision work with ease. This skidded power tool is compact enough to cram into tight spots, and also includes a handy dust ejection design that helps the engine hold up over time. Safety is also a concern. The hand guard rotates completely around the tool to give you complete protection against any sparks or debris that are kicked up while you work. You also get a hard case that will make it safe and easy to transport. In accordance with DeWalt's pattern, this is an expensive tool through angle grinding standards. The high levels of power can also be a bit much for beginners. If you are not well-inset with grinders, you can over-grind the workpiece. All in all, this is one of the best 4.5 angle grinders of 2020. 2. Milwaukee 2780-20 Angle Grinder Milwaukee 2780-20 has much in common with DeWalt. It is powerful, with an adjustable hand guard, a hard-plated carrying case and a special design to protect the inner workings from dust. Our main concern about this tool concerns value. Buyer's Guide Below you will find some buying considerations to help you choose the perfect angle grinder for all your future projects. Disc Size The sander disc or wheel is indicative of both the unit's power and its total capacity. Larger discs generally mean a more powerful tool. Smaller discs are usually more optimal for focus jobs, or tasks that require lots of precision. When choosing for size, it is important to carefully consider what kind of work you will eventually use this grinder for. Will you touch of tight angles and smaller spaces? If so, you will almost certainly be better served by a more compact compact Mill. If you have high volume work, a large disc will help you produce a smooth finish in much less time. Strange, isn't it? You'd think that every tool would be made for the human hand, but unfortunately, no. They needed a special word for it. Ergonomic tools will usually be more convenient to use. This can involve a special seal, or even a unique design pattern that naturally funnels dust away from the device's delicate electrical inner work. HandGuard Some grinders have special protection to protect your hands from splinters and sparks. It is not a necessary feature, but it can be useful to have. You can also find adjustable handguards that can be changed to suit the needs of each unique job you work with. The nice thing is that, at least as far as power tools go, this is a relatively cheap one. Since the price of a decent mill is generally quite modest, even budget buyers are in a position where they can get something really solid.
