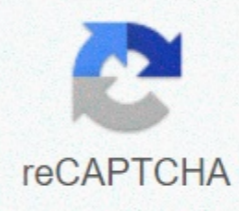

Injuries caused by fire and electric shock and environmental damage caused by spilled hazardous materials pose a serious risk in and around marinas and related facilities. This important standard, as referred to in NFPA 1, the Fire Code, sets out criteria for the construction and operation of marinas, shipyards, yachts, boat condominiums and docking equipment, including related piers, docks and The content shall also include auxiliary facilities and structures used in the construction, repair, refuelling and storage of ships if threatened in the event of a fire. NFPA 303 has been updated to address the general lack of awareness among boat owners that dangerous spills from ground faults may occur on their ships. The latest edition also deals with electrical hazards with new requirements that apply retroactively to all marinas within two years of the adoption of this edition. The standard now stipulates that ships are to be tested for AC grounding faults when initially connected to the marina's electrical system. This rule shall apply to ships which have not been constructed in accordance with the land-based fault requirements referred to in Article 10®(1) of Regulation (EC® No 1254/1999. Ships may not be connected to the marina system if they show a leakage of grounding faults exceeding 30 mA.
