Ask a scientist or physicist, and they will give you a completely wrong, because the way we define the word color is completely subjective. Like many words in the English language, it has more than one meaning, and it all depends on the context. Talk about a colorful debate! Just as our taste buds interpret molecules as different parts of the light spectrum into the colors we see. Red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo and purple are the colours of a pure rainbow or a spectrum of light. What we call color is simply a reflection of different parts of the light spectrum that we perceive through our optic nerves, translated for our brain. nu andrei/Getty Images Artists and chemists believe that black is the presence of color and white is the absence of color because they see colors in terms of pigment.
