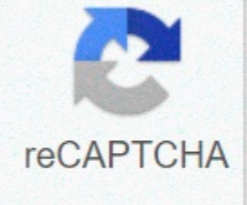

Hopkinton Town Hall is open as of Monday 2020 and only pre-booked appointments are available. To make an appointment with a city hall employee, contact the department directly to reserve an interactive time slot. If you arrive for a confirmed appointment, all visitors must wear a face cover during their visit. Visitors are also required to fill out a COVID-19 proof form in advance or upon arrival. All individuals with symptoms of COVID-19 are asked to stay home and readjust their commitments. The Hopkinton Senior Center is physically closed but still offers a lot of services. As of September 18, 2020, the library building is limited and open to the public. The initial pilot phase is for quick browsing and material checkout. Time and service will expand as soon as possible. Curbside pickups are available for at least a few weeks.
