It was the first series developed by the well-known brand Neversoft. After development, it was distributed and marketed by RedOctane and Activision. Guitar Hero 3 was first released for the PlayStation 2, PlayStation 2, Wii and Xbox 360 consoles. It was later also released for Microsoft Windows and Apple's Macintosh too. In total there are 73 guitars hero 3 songs. Of these 73 songs, 39 are single-won songs, three Boss Battle songs, six cooperative careers songs and 25 bonus songs. These songs are available as downloadable content for xbox 360 and PlayStation 3. Guitar Hero 3 was packed with 73 songs that spread in both Solo and Co-Op career mode. Based on the level of their complexity, these songs were arranged in eight tiers in sequence. To access the next song, the player must complete some or all of the songs present in a particular tier. If you enter or open a level once, then you have the right to access all songs except encores and battle songs. The encore of the song can be accessed as soon as you finish the tier. One thing you should know is that these three battle songs cannot be played outside of solo career mode. If you're playing this game on an Xbox 360 or PlayStation 3, then you're lucky enough to get them in the form of downloadable content.
