God told Moses to return to Egypt, confront Pharaoh, and get the Israelites out of Egypt. Moses refused at first, so hesitant that the Lord's wrath was on fire against Moses. But after a long discussion with God, complete with several signs of a convincing miracle, Moses gathered his family and set out for Egypt. However, in the way God once again became angry, God sought to kill him by making him dangerously ill. We know that God did not kill Moses, so what happened? In numbers 11:14-15, what was Moses' reaction? A: He told God that he could not bear the burden and wanted to be dead. According to numbers 11:1-3, people were complaining and God's wrath, so he sent a fire that destroyed some of their camp. Although Moses prayed to end the fire at the people's request, they continued to complain. The rabble who were among them were greedy desires, but the children of Israel also cried and said: Who will give us the meat to eat?
