You can also buy a specific annual pass in the park for \$70. Tackle the highest peak in The Lasen National Volcanic Park and stand above an active volcano. Located four hours northeast of San Francisco this Northern California Park may be a bit of a road, but it's a major destination for quiet seekers and those who even have a fleeting interest in geology. Mount Lasen is a towering testimony to the volcanic origins of this area, and a majestic view of the trail on the shores of Lake Helen. Starting from the car park in Lassen National Park, this popular effect makes a sharp upto-top Lassen Peak. Height can be difficult, but views are worth the effort. It's really an adventure worth its value to the top of an active volcano. On the main road through Lassen National Park, the parking lot in the trail marks the beginning of the journey. The track starts at 8,500 feet high, and climbs quickly. The high altitude in combination with a steep ascent can make this altitude difficult, but the path is relatively short, just 2.5 miles in each direct sunlight the entire trip.
