Coruscant is said to have 5,217 levels, although it actually has 5,127. [3] Complete locations say that the Delta-7 Aethersprite-class light interceptor was created in response to the invasion of Naboo. The star wars 26 comic, set before the invasion of Naboo, featured Delta 7s.[4] Endorsing the population is said to be Unknown. But Star Wars: Everything you need to know has previously stated that there are over 30,000,000 Ewoks. [5] Geonosis' population is reported to be 100 million, while Star Wars: Absolutely Everything You Need to Know says it is 100 billion. [5] Full places also say that there was no population of geonosis during the imperial period. This contradicts the Star Wars Rebels episode Ghosts of Geonosis, in which Klik-Klak, the sole survivor of the galactic empire's sterilization of geonosis, protects a Queen egg. [6] The kashyk planet profile incorrectly uses an image of Dagobah. Lott Dod is reported to have been present during the first Battle of Geonosis in the bow box at petranaki arena. Although Episode II identified that Neimoidian as Dod, Neimoidian is believed to be Rune Haako. While Complete Locations says Naboo has only one moon, Mace Windu mentions spice miners on the moons of Naboo in Star Wars: Episode II Attack of The Clones. [7] Thrawn: Alliances later stated that Naboo has three moons. [8] King Veruna is said to have ruled for thirteen years. But Queen's Shadow later determined that Naboo's monarch could rule for a maximum of four years. [9] Yoda's Hut is said to have been destroyed by Dagobah's torrential downpours after Yoda's death. However, the 2015 book Ultimate Star Wars has previously stated that it was recovered by the swamp and the many creatures Yoda befriended during his exile. [10] After being asked about this, Leland Chee replied that the information from both sources may be canonical, explaining that the cabin could have been recovered right after Yoda's death, but destroyed a hundred years later. [11] Yoda's lightsaber is revealed to have been stored in a box at Yoda's Hut in 3 ABY. But the cartoon Darth Vader: Dark Lord of the Sith 1 says that the lightsaber was destroyed during the celebration of the extermination of the Jedi Order in 19 BBY. When asked about this, writer Charles Soule mused that perhaps Yoda built a new one, that he had more than one or that Darth Sidious built a fake to make a point,[13] while Lucasfilm Story Group's Matt Martin clarified that they are aware of it, but it is not a mistake that Yoda certainly had more than a few lightsaber during his lifetime. [14] The book mentions that after seeing Anakin's lightsaber while in Ben Kenobi's home, C-3Po's protocol programming required him to shut down to protect his ex-owner's secrets. Pablo Hidalgo confirmed that this information should have been cut from the book.
