It was released on November 21, 2006 by Doggystyle Records and Geffen Records. Filming took place from November 2005 to October 2007. The album debuted at Number 5 on the US Billboard 200, selling 264,000 copies in its first week. [1] Following its release, Tha Blue Carpet Treatment received generally positive reviews from music critics. The album was promoted with Tha Blue Carpet Treatment Mixtape, which was released days before the album's official release. Background Album title, Tha Blue Carpet Treatment is a reference to the red carpet traditionally present at festive events. Blue refers to the affiliation of Snoop Dogg gangs of Crips, who often wear blue (as opposed to primary color, red, their rival gang Bloods). [quote required] The album cover has undergone several revisions. In August 2006, he was 15 years old. It features a cartoon dog (represented by Snoop Dogg) showing crip gang signals, while standing on a gang-like blue carpet. The design was used, which would be the third cover of Snoop Dogg's album to use the cartoon to like the rapper designed by his cousin Darryl Daniel. An updated version of his cover was featured on The Late Show with David Letterman's 13th Anniversary Special on August 30, 2006, and that cover features a parody of the famous Hollywood sign, which reads LONG BEACH. It has changed to the current version. Geffen announced this as the last album cover on his website. [2] Snoop Dogg directed to take Long Beach back in gangsta root. The rapper MTV.com accepting his true nature to the album; stating: I went back to the 'hood, he said about the production of his album. I got it back to basics. I did a lot of pop songs, a lot of R&B songs. Songs that might have made my fans feel like I was waving off from what I was naturally used to doing. But I'm an entertainer and I entertain people and that's what I felt at the time. But now, I feel like I'm going back to the hood. Pharrell said the rapper's music video, Vato will not only show his gangsta side, but also address the issue of violence between African Americans and Hispanics in Los Angeles, California, and call for racial unity. Snoop Dogg would team up with famous DJs from the West, East and South by releasing Tha Blue Carpet Treatment Mixtape, hosted by DJ Skee, DJ Whoo Kid and DJ Drama. It contained all the rumors that had been cut from the final list of his studio album. It was released a few weeks before the release of the official album. [3] Think About It was composed by Frequency in his dorm room a year and a half before the album, while Frequency was a student in Virginia. The material was passed on to Mike Chavez of Geffen Records, who gave it to Snoop Dogg. Snoop Dogg uses the track to show his older son - who didn't pick him as his favorite hip-hop artist when asked - that he can still be an old-school gangster rapper about his style if he wants to. [4] A song called Imagine was to be featured on Buste Rhymes' The Big Bang album. Busta Rhymes said in several interviews, before the Big Bang came out, that the pattern for Imagine was still trying to clean up. Busta Rhymes stated that he wasn't sure the sample would be cleared in time for his album's release, so he had to be excluded from his album. Because the pattern was not cleaned at the time, and it is assumed [according to whom?] that the song was given to Snoop Dogg for his album. It was recorded with lyrics by Kam and Snoop Dogg (in different from the album version) as they played during the TBCT Listening Party. [6] Although Busta Rhymes posted a remix on Imagine, it's probably[according to whom?] his remix when it was actually the original version that didn't work out on the Big Bang release. Artists such as Nas, Ja Rule and Black-Ty have done their freestyles on this track. [7] The Music Which One of You was recorded during the album sessions in its process, with a group called N.V. The song was led by the production team in 1500. [7] Round Here contains the same pattern on the song Thank You performed by Dido, in which it became the same pattern used by fellow American rapper Eminem for his song Stan. So Snoop Dogg wasn't aware of when recorded this track during recording. [7] L.A.X. contains a sample of More Bounce to the Ounce performed by Zapp, in which Snoop Dogg has already used this sample song once on one of his earlier songs, Snoop Bounce, in which he was included from his album Tha Doggfather (1996). All three songs – That's That Shit, Boss' Life and Imagine – have lyrics written by former Aftermath Entertainment performers such as Stat Quo (Benton, S.) and The D.O.C. (Curry, T.). Recording Snoop Dogg told Billboard that he had been working on this album, Tha Blue Carpet Treatment, for nine months. He collaborated with R. Kelly on the album's biggest track, titled That's That produced by Nottz and others on ice cube, Pharrell, D'Angelo, Akon, Nate Dogg, B-Real (from Cypress Hill) and even Stevie Wonder. He also confirmed that Dr. Dre had a great contribution to this album, producing several tracks and even rapping a verse on the song, Imagine. Dr. Dre hasn't produced Snoop Dogg's leads since 2000. He also wanted me to fuck you with Akon, but he had to release a cleaned-up version for a radio show called I Want to Love You. Other songs recorded for this album did not make the final cut, including Wannabes featuring 'Young Jeezy and Nate Dogg; produced by DJ Quika, Smokin' Smokin' Weed, which featured Ray J, Slim Thug, Shorty Mack and Nate Dogg, and Put This Thang on You with Ne-Yo, only two of them (except on You Put This Thang) were published in disc two that is, in a bonus song disc. The album retained generally positive reviews with IGN calling it one of Snoop's strongest efforts in a long time, with beats, rhymes and guests praising Doggfather with great immediacy. She received 4 out of 5 Allhiphop.com, About.com and Allmusic. Ryan Dombal for Entertainment Weekly wrote that Blue Carpet finds him redirected and reunited with Dr. Dre on four tracks. The two stand out nostalgically for 'Imagine'. - Grade: B+[19] Vibe magazine wrote that Tha Blue Carpet Treatment stands as a powerful statement from a veteran who is still pushing his artistic boundaries. [8] Blender wrote that album A throwback to his trunk-rattling G-funk heyday. - Grade: 3.5 out of five stars. [8] XXL wrote that Snoop's lyrical fire seems resurrected, for he brings arguably his most consistent glowing work after. Christian Hoard for Rolling Stone wrote that Snoop's eighth LP does little to break the trend. Production is hot, with high-def beats that range from cheated funk (Dr. Dre's Boss's Life) to a dark, tense bounce (the excellent Neptunes-produced Vato). Radio-friendly ups – R. Kelly feature That's That – balance brawny head-nodders like Gangbangin 101. Snoop sounds great dropping streams of consonant on Think About It, and few rappers could make a minimalist Drop It Like It's Hot cut like Candy (Drippin' Like Water) sound so unique. Nathan Rabin for The A.V. Club reviewed the album and wrote that Snoop had always been able to knock out addictive radio singles, but his albums generally stranded a few knockout songs amid an ocean of lazy filler, opportunistic trend-hopping and derivatives, second-rate G-funk. Sleepy, anticlimactic recent reunion albums by Dogg Pound and 213 (Snoop, Warren G and Nate Dogg) failed to awaken Snoop from his long-standing professional funk. Why does Snoop's shockingly good Tha Blue Carpet treatment sound more like a loose, revitalized sequel to? Dr. Dre's reappearance certainly doesn't hurt. Dre has always brought the best in Snoop, and his presence seems to have reignited Snoop's passion and hunger. No song better exemplates the disc ethos of delirious excesses from Candy (Drippin' Like Water), the insanely addictive candy-uplit R&B song with clever nods to hyphy (E-40 and producer Rick Rock) and retro jazz-rap (see that crazy digable Planets pattern), plus guest raps from a small army of past gangstas. When faced with a choice, Snoop inevitably chooses all of the above here. So Treatment gives listeners Dr. Dre and Neptunes, The Game and Ice Cube, red-hot polygamy enthusiast Akon and old standby Nate Dogg, George Clinton and Stevie Wonder, gangsta shit, pimp shit, and at least one song encouraging pee-wee football players to go hard or go home. With his lush Blue Carpet treatment, Snoop Dogg finally looks like he intends to build and expand his musical legacy, rather than just leaning on it.
