If you picked up Everstar's portable air conditioner at Home Depot a few years ago, then you know how great these little machines are. These mobile units do a fantastic job keeping you cool during the dog days of summer. But if you look like me, you probably have no idea where you put the manual. Since they don't make these air conditioners anymore, it can be a little tricky tracking information about these portable air conditioners. Do not worry. We're taking care of you. Below you will find a description of the nine most common problems people have with these Everstar units. And we've even provided a DIY fix for the most common problems we've seen with these units. Most issues can be addressed in a few moments. And the most expensive DIY tip we have for you below will set you back about 20 bucks. So stop dismantling the garage and digging through all the boxes to try to find the guide. Everything you need to know will be described here. Problem #1: Help! My MPK-10CR doesn't cool down and it keeps flashing P1! So far, the most common problem we see with Everstar units is that the P-1 indicator LIGHT is blinking. While this may seem ominous, the reality is that P-1 Light visit a very simple problem to fix. Basically, P1 says one of two things. First, it could be that the water tank has been bumped into place. The unit washes this signal so you can replace the water tank so the water doesn't flush into the other components. The reason you'll see the P1 lighting is because the unit tells you that the suspension unit is full of water. That's a pretty easy fix, too. Just drain the water tank. Here's how: Step 1– Remove the drain plug, which will be located at the back of the unit. If you still have the drainage pipe thrown, go ahead and plug it into the drain plug. You can use this drain is to draw the water from the unit. If you don't have the drainage pipe, simply remove the plug and return the unit to the bucket to remove the collected occupation. Depending on the unit you have, you may also be able to remove the entire water tank and empty the water. Step 2 – Make sure that you carefully replace the water tank if you have removed it. The humidity lowerer will start taking the moisture out of the air in about 5 minutes after the compressor kicks in again. If you use your Everstar unit in your basement, there's a cool feature for you I don't know about. Basically, if you have a floor to drain your basement, you can set up your air conditioner so it's on a continuous drainage option. To do this, you simply keep the drainage pipe discussed earlier attached to a drainage plug and feed it down into your basement floor drain. My #2 problem: My Everstar air conditioner won't work with my extension cable! Another common problem in Everstar units occurs when people move them or someone picks up a used unit and doesn't understand the electrical specifications. While these machines are tiny, they use a reasonable amount of power and attract 9.6 amps when they are in cooling mode. To be sure, it's best to run them in your typical 15A grounded home container. Some people encountered problems when they tried to plug the unit into a wall socket in their home that is not properly grounded. If you're worried about it, be sure to talk to a qualified electrician. Another thing to keep in mind here is that you need to use a plug adapter or extension cord with this unit. The #3: Someone told me that Everstar's windowless air conditioning shouldn't be about collecting the window. What's the deal with this duct? It's a little wrong to call everstar units without windows. In fact, all portable AC units should be placed near a glass sliding window or door so that they can be properly unloaded using the exhaust pipe. Another common problem we see with Everstar units is that the exhaust pipe is not properly connected to the window. Everstar units come standard with a window set to help you set up the vent with a horizontal window or casement style. People often set up their units and then find out they're not working properly. One of the most common issues we see with ventilation, however, is that the water tank can be accidentally displaced when you move the unit around. In this case, you will receive the P-1 warning light as discussed above. So if you recently moved your unit or you just reinstall it for the summer, just take a few moments and make sure that the water tank is in the right position. Another common complaint that consumers have is that plastic pipes for an event can get cracked and broken down over time. After all, the tube is located right next to the window where it is exposed to harsh sunlight every day. If that happens, you're going to have to track down a new one. Finding a replacement tube can be a bit of a pain, however, since they don't actually make these units anymore. The best bet is to call some local air conditioning stores and ask them if they have a portable air conditioner hose that can be purchased. We went through some of these pipes with our mobile unit and they usually cost about \$15 or \$20 to replace. While some people were trying Pipe dryer as an alternative to ac exhaust pipe, we do not recommend it. Not only can it cancel your responsibility for the unit, but you really want to make sure you have the right size exhaust pipe for your Everstar unit. Because most dryer vent tubes are only 4 inches in diameter, they won't fit comfortably in the 5-inch exhaust pipe area of your Everstar unit. Another common question about the pipeline arises when people want one that is longer than a standard 1.5-metre pipe. Some people want to use the unit in a room that doesn't have easy access to the window (like a basement) or they want to put the unit further out the window for better cooling. You can find ducts are going up to about 30 feet. As we said before, just call your local hospitality shops to see what they have in terms of portable air conditioner pipes. Remember, however, that you don't want to so the tube bent at an angle greater than 90° at any point. If you do, the duct will be much less efficient and the air conditioning just won't be cool either. We have one last comment on the ventilation duct. Never, ever use that mobile merge without him. If you let this unit — or any portable air conditioning — operate without a vent, the hot air will come out of the back of the machine and straight into the room you're trying to cool down. The problem #4 – the unit seems to turn off and off as if it were possessed! Sometimes, you can hear the fan running but you notice there is no cool air coming from the machine. This is a common problem at the beginning of the summer season or if you have just picked up one of these used units. The good news is the fix is pretty simple. You just have to reset the thermostat. Apparently, the thermostat in the unit was set to a certain temperature. Once the room reaches this temperature, you may be facing a situation where the machine has been programmed to cool only up to that level. These Everstar units come with a set timer that can be a little confusing. Here's some tips for resetting it. Start by holding down the Mode key until you see the Cool Slider LIGHT. Then press the down arrow or up arrow keys until you reach the temperature setting you want. This option will be displayed in the LED display window. You can choose a setting anywhere between 62°F and 88°F. The green indicator light should come about to tell you that the air conditioning mode has begun. Don't worry if there's a delay, it usually takes up to 30 seconds for this cycle to start. The next setting you want to take a look at is the fan setting. You have 3 options to choose from: High, Medium, or Low. The #5 problem is, O-O. The compressor on my Everstar portable air conditioner has stopped working! Another common complaint we're hearing about these Everstar units is that compressor Break. Apparently, however, the compressor is ok and there is only an easy adjustment that needs to be made. As discussed earlier, if the water tank gets bumped or sprained somehow, the compressor will enter its safety feature and stop working. Furthermore, it will automatically start flashing P-1 light which indicates that the tank is full. Many people are confused by this – especially at the beginning of the summer season – because they know the tank can't be full. It's just a strange bit of an Everstar unit that will automatically point out that the tank must be drained. Another thing to keep in mind is that the compressor simply won't work as long as the red P-1 flashes. So here's your troubleshooting guide if the compressor stops: Step 1: Check if the water tank is actually full. If so, follow the instructions above to empty it. Step 2: Determine whether the water tank is pulled aside during a move or repositioning. If so, just slide it back into place. You know you solved the problem when the red light stops flashing. The #6 – we just had heat outside and my Everstar air conditioning stopped working even when the electricity came back on. Another common problem we see with these units is that they can sometimes encounter problems if you are hit with blackout or blackout during the hot summer months. For example, if the unit is refrigerated for dehumidifier in the state and it temporarily loses power (also approximately 3-5 minutes), the compressor protection circuit will be activated. The result is a green flashing light on the status indicator, which will take about 10 seconds. This is just a safety check so the prep can detect if the compressor is protected or not. You will notice that the compressor does not work during this compressor protection phase. Do not worry. That doesn't mean anything's wrong. Just wait about 5 minutes and compressor protection should be turned off automatically. Problem #7: How can I set up my Everstar windowless air conditioner so it starts to cool down before I come home from work? Most Everstar mobile AC units come with an automatic timer that allows you to program the unit to shut down or turn on the specified time. Some people have problems with this feature because the unit can be a bit of a loophole with a feature as well. , and then select the number of hours you want it to remain running. The stupid thing about this feature is that you will need to set the hour time on a daily basis. The unit won't remember it every day. Also, keep in mind that if the unit suffers a power outage, it will be storage. On the other hand, you might want to set up your air conditioner so that it is automatically Before you get home from work. To set the AutoPlay feature, you must make sure the unit is not working. Then use the arrows to select the number of hours you want to go before the unit starts automatically. Again, it will have to end on a daily basis. Problem #8: Where can I get Everstar portable air conditioner filters? Since you can no longer buy these Everstar units at your local Home Depot, it is imperative that you take good care of your air conditioner to ensure it lasts for years to come. Here are some basic maintenance tips to complete routinely. Before you address any of these problems, be sure to disconnect the unit from its power source. Also, do not use chemicals outside the unit because they can wreak havoc on the plastic casing. The most common maintenance phase (and one that many users often neglect) is to keep the air filter clean. If you let the filter get too dirty, the efficiency of your Everstar unit will greatly decrease. Ideally, you should remove the air filter and clean it at least twice a month. Here are the steps you need to take to get the air filter nice and clean: Step 1: Unplug the unit and rotate it so that your back faces you. Step 2: Grab the air filter tab. Release him by pulling him out first and then picking him up. Step 3: Use the vacuum to clean all the dust and dirt on the filter. It can also be washed with warm soapy water. Dishwashing soap is the best. Make sure that the filter is washed until the water runs clean and allow it to dry completely before you return it to the machine. If your air filter isn't in very bad shape, consider buying a new filter. Just take the old filter to every home improvement store and ask them for a replacement. Filters can be fairly cheap, starting at \$10. Also – and this is important – never, ever turn on your air conditioning without an air filter installed. You can destroy your unit if you don't have an air filter while it's running. The problem #9: the remote won't work and I'm too hot to go and run the machine. If you're still lucky enough to know where your sign is (we lost ours eons ago), the most common complaint we see is that the damn thing just stops working. Apparently, the fix is simple. It probably just needs new batteries. Here are some things to keep in mind about the batteries for the remote control: Make sure you're using two AAA batteries. Never use old batteries. It could make the sign suck up. If you're going to use a remote for more than two weeks – or you put the unit away for winter – be sure to remove the batteries. If they don't, they could leak and destroy your sign. The way to say you have to completely replace the batteries is that when you The buttons, no beeping from the unit. Then you've got it. These fixes will solve the most common problems with the Everstar unit in a matter of minutes. Good luck and stay calm! Cool!

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
