Craigslist has a huge user base for job seekers and consumers of all kinds. To ensure your ad not only ends up on the Craigslist site, but attracts the applicants you want, take the time to create a short but effective ad that tailors the skills you want. Entrepreneur recommends putting four of the five skills in your ad that matter most in the position you hire. Stay away from mentioning personality traits, as applicants can mimic them in correspondence or during interviews. Focus on the skills needed to do the job successfully, such as strong sales skills for a commission-based sales job. Mentioning that commissions are an important part of one's earning potential will eliminate anyone who is not motivated enough to sell. Craigslist lists numerous job categories to post offers under, so think about who will surf the vacancies and categorize them appropriately. For example, if you are posting for a receptionist at a TV studio, ask yourself if you want a strong office worker or a young on-air personality looking for an introduction to the industry. If the first one is, place the task under admin/office. If it's the latter, add it to TV/movie/video. By Shelley Frost Craigslist is an online advertising website distributed in different city areas. Users place ads in categories such as Services, For Sale, Jobs, Housing, Community, and Personal. Basic knowledge of Craigslist allows users to communicate securely with each other. Craigslist divides its ads into different categories. Anyone can place an ad with or without a Craigslist account. If you create an account, you can easily access all your messages to review or delete them. Without an account, you'll receive an email after you post a message with links to change the ad. Click the Post link to ads in the upper-left corner of each page on the Craigslist website to create an ad. Fill the template fields, including title books, place text, and additional details such as Price and Condition. It may take a few minutes for the ad to appear in the category on the selected city's Craigslist page. If you're interested in browsing the Craigslist ads, select the nearest city on the right side of the Craigslist page. The main page of your city's page displays the ads organized under main categories. Subcategories are listed below to help you find the specific items you want. The For Sale section includes categories such as antiques, books, furniture and jewelry. Click the category you want to see a list of ads placed from newest to oldest. You have the ability to sort these ads by price rather than chronological order. You also see the ads from the selected category as expandable info bubbles on a map based on the buyer's location. On Craigslist, all negotiations and transactions take place directly between buyer and seller. An interested seller contacts the person with questions, then can eventually commit to buy an item and make arrangements to comply. Read all the ad details before you respond. Each Craigslist ad contains an answer button in the upper-left corner. Click the Reply button to display all of the poster's contact methods. Craigslist offers a service that masks the seller's email address so that it looks like a Craigslist email address and every email sent to the address, Craigslist automatically forwards to the seller's personal email address. Users choose whether they want their actual email addresses or the Craigslist version to appear when creating the ad. Since you interact with strangers on Craigslist, take precautions to protect your identity when you post an ad. Plan to meet in a public location, such as a busy parking lot. In some neighborhoods, police stations encourage Craigslist users to comply outside the station for transactions. Take someone or tell another person where you're going. If the situation seems suspicious, trust your instincts and leave. Never transfer money or pay for anything for a meeting with the person. By Steve McDonnell If you're writing a personal ad for Craigslist and don't forget reading an ad from someone else you want to copy and modify, you use the Wayback Machine to retrieve archived versions of the Craigslist website and find the old Craigslist personals ad. Select the date from the calendar closest to the date you read the personal ad you're looking for and has a blue circle that indicates that an archived version is available. F)PICK-UP/DELIVERY1)When you find what you're looking for, you'll meet somewhere in public. This means shopping locally. While certain areas have better deals on certain items, it's much safer to have a face-to-face deal. In addition to insuring you're not scammed by an email scam, it gives you a chance to inspect the merchandise before giving up cash. Some sellers are willing to provide free or additional compensation. Just ask. If you plan to pick up the item, arrange it with the seller. Take someone and only pay cash (unless we're talking about huge sums of money). Be sure to inspect the item before you pay. It is a virtual yard sale, afterall - 99% of sellers will probably not be willing to offer refunds. That brings another point worth mentioning: you don't have to say yes. If you are planning to meet someone to buy something, be clear that you want to inspect the item or items, and that if they are in poor condition, or not as advertised, you will walk away. This is your right, and if a seller has a problem with it, you probably don't want to have to deal with them, anyway. If the person is good and the item is as described, then by all means make the purchase. But use cash. It's the best way to keep things honest, easy and just. If you sell, don't accept cheques, even cashier cheques or money orders, as they are easy to counterfeit. Your bank holds you responsible if you deposit a fake check. Also, stay away from wire services because there are a number of scams that use these services to rob you blind. Don't ship your product to anyone in Europe either, okay? You'll be surprised by how many emails you get with requests like that. G)OTHER NOTES:1)Now that we know what to do, let's talk about what not to do. Don't show up late without calling. Don't stand up to your buyer or seller, that's just awful. Don't hurt your salesman if they make a mistake, they're not pros. Don't worry about getting down on someone who's ripping you off, though. There's nothing wrong with that. That.
