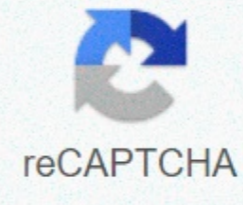

As of 2018-2019, the school enrolled 1,613 students and 118.4 classroom teachers (based on FTE), for a teacher pupil ratio of 13.6:1. 41 students (2.5% of enrollment) were eligible for the free lunch, while 17 (1.1% of students) were eligible for lunch at a reduced cost. [1] The district group's J rating indicates that the school serves students with relatively high socioeconomic status. [3] The history of the School was accredited by the Association of Secondary Staffs of Colleges and Schools of the Primary and Secondary Schools Commission from 1976[4] until 2013, when the school's accreditation status was lifted. [5] Awards, recognition, and ratings For the 1992-93 school year, Montgomery High School was awarded the U.S. Department of Education's National Blue Ribbon School of Excellence.[6] the highest award an American school can receive. [7] In The Washington Post's 2011 issue of Ranking America's High Schools, the school ranked 13th in New Jersey and 636th nationwide. [9] The school ranked 643rd nationwide, 18th in New Jersey, in Newsweek magazine's 2010 ranking of America's best high schools. [10] In a May 22, 2007 issue of Newsweek, ranked first in high schools in the country, Montgomery High School was ranked 656th, 13th in New Jersey. The school was the 33rd public school in New Jersey from 339 New Jersey state schools in September 2014 in New Jersey Monthly magazine on the cover of the state's Top Public High Schools magazine, using a new ranking methodology. In 2012, the school was ranked 61st in the state out of 328 schools, after ranked 10th in 2010 listed schools. In 2008, the magazine ranked 16th at the school out of 316 schools. In September 2006, the school was ranked 4th in the journal's issue, which included 316 schools around the state. [15] Schooldigger.com ranked 39th in a school out of 381 public high schools nationwide in its 2011 ranking (a 7-position decline from the 2010 rankings) that were based on a combined percentage of students classified as experienced or higher proficient in math (93.3%) and language literacy (98.1%) higher education assessment (HSPA). Montgomery testing was recognized in 2006 as excellent in the art history of extended placement; all 203 students who passed the AP exam this year scored 3 (of 5) or higher. [17] SAT Scores In 2005-2006, Montgomery averaged 1,760 combined SAT scores, 15th highest in the state, and ranked 7th among all non-magnets, general admissions public high schools. [18] In 2006-07, Montgomery averaged a 1,755 SAT score, the 14th highest in the state and the 7th highest for any non-magnet, general admissions public high school. [19] Student Events Clubs and Editions of Montgomery High School offers several academic, collaborative training and sports club programs. [20] In Science, Montgomery High School has the first team of robotics competitions, TSA TEAMS, science league, science bowl and science olympiad. The band's program also offers several extracurricular activities, including: a march band that plays at every varsity football match and at various competitions where they received great scores and special awards such as Best Overall Effect, Best Color Guard and Best Music; jazz band; and a lower-level jazz group called Stage Band. All musical ensembles are uncompetitive, and only attend competitions at the exhibition. The yearbook is called lens and, since 2007, is printed in full color. Every year, a video known as older video is released for the senior class. The video looks back at time spent in Montgomery by outgoing seniors and consists of a wide variety of video footage, from an annual senior class trip to Disney World all the way to kindergarten. It has historically been handled by the TELEVISION department, however since 2008 it has been made as a joint venture between the TELEVISION department and the class historian for the graduating class. The video is shown once, at the senior dinner dance. The school has other extracurriculars. Future Business Leaders of America Club competed for the first time in competitions and 9 out of 11 people were accommodated in the regions and went to the states and three people left and placed at the national competition. Pawprint is a school newspaper, MHS. MHS also offers a literary magazine that is published annually. Students can submit poems, prose, photography, as well as traditional and digital works of art. The first robotics Montgomery High School is home to Team 1403, Cougar Robotics, which has been participating in the First Robotics Competition since 2004. Over the years, they have been to worlds competitions 8 times, earned 6 blue banners, won 34 awards such as the Xerox Creativity Award, Motorola Quality Award, Chrysler Team Spirit Award, Excellence in Engineering Award, Industrial Design Award, etc. were finalists at 9 Events, and won at 2 Events Scientific Olympiad Scientific Olympiad in Montgomery From 1997 to 2005, the school won the New Jersey State championship nine times in a row, each time qualifying for a national tournament. The nine state titles are the largest of any high school in the state. [21] Athletics Montgomery High School of the Couma[2] competes with a member of the Skyland Conference, which includes community and parish high schools spanning Hunterdon County, Somerset County and Warren County in western Central Jersey, and operates under the jurisdiction of the New Jersey State Intersola Athletic Association (NJSIAA). [22] Of the 1,270 students in grades 10 through 12, the school was classified by NJSIAA for the 2015-16 school year as Central Jersey, Group IV for most sports competitions, which included schools with registrations of 1,082 to 2,349 students in that class. [23] The school was classified by NJSIAA as Group IV North for football for 2018-2020. [24] The sport offered at Montgomery High School includes golf, wrestling, soccer, running wrestling, cross-country running, baseball, soccer, ice hockey, basketball, lacrosse, softball, swimming, gymnastics, fencing, cheerleading and track. The school participates in a joint hockey team with Hopewell Valley Central School as a host school/leading agency. The cooperative program operates under agreements that expire at the end of the 2023-24 academic year. [25] The 1991 football team finished the season with a 14-4-2 record after winning the Group I state championship with a 1-0 victory against Glen Rock High School in the final game of the tournament at Trenton State College. [26] In 1993, the Boy Tennis Team won the State I Championship (against Haddonfield Memorial High School), 1997 (vs. Pitman High School), 1998 (vs. Madison High School) and 1999 (vs. Haddonfield), and won the Group IV title in 2017 (against Livingston High School), 2018 (vs. Westfield High School) and 2019 (vs. Montclair High School). The team won the Champions Tournament in 2017 (defeating newark Academy runner-up in the final match of the tournament), 2018 (vs. West Windsor Plainsboro High School South) and 2019 (vs. Newark Academy). In 2004, the girls' swimming team won the Public Group B state championship and the Public B title in 2015. The boys' team won the Public Group B title in 2020. [29] The girls' team in football was group III In 2005 with Moorestown High School and won the Group IV state championship with a 1-0 victory over Ridge High School in 2012. In 2003, the hockey team won the Dauda Cup. In 2004, the softball team won the NJSIAA Group III state championship. [32] They also won the tournament in Somerset County in 2009. In 2005, athletics teams were won in North II Group III. The [required citation] baseball team won the 2005 North II Group III state championship with a 3-1 victory over Millburn High School. In 2006 and 2011, 2011 at NJSIAA Public School of Ice Hockey dropped to Randolph High School both times in the final of the 64-team tournament. [35] The Lacrosse Boys team won the Group III State Championship (winning the final of the Randolph High School tournament) and also won group IV titles in 2017 (against Ridgewood High School) and 2019 (against Hunterdon Central Regional High School). The team won the 2007 Group III state championship with a 10-8 victory in the playoff final over Randolph High School. [37] In 2007, the maiden tennis team won the Central Jersey State Championship, Group IV with a 3-2 victory over West Windsor-Plainsboro High School South in the tournament final. [38] The team won the Group I state championship in 1994 against Verona High School and in 1996 against Mountain Lakes High School. The team won the Group II championship in 2002 against Summit High School. [39] The boys' basketball team won the Central Jersey Group IV section title in 2010 with a 57-30 victory over North Brunswick High School.[40] and won their respective conference championship in 1975, 2000, 2001, 2003, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2018. In 2010, the boys' tennis team won the Central Jersey Group IV section title with a 3-2 victory over West Windsor Plainsboro High School South. In 2011 and 2019, the girls' team was the winner of the épée team, and in 2016 became the winner of the foul team. [42] In 2011, 2012 and 2015, boys' golf teams won the Central/South Group IV State Championship. [citation required] The boys' fencing team won the foil team in 2019. Varsity Cheerleading qualified for the National Currency in the 2010-2011 and 2011-2012 seasons. Varsity's junior squad qualified for the nationals for the 2011-2012 season, placing first place in Empire Regionals at Hofstra University. [required citation] The administration of the School Principal is Paul J. Popadyuk. The main administrative team includes three vice directors.
