

View DealThe EcoTank ET-2760 (C11CG22203) is not the cheapest or most capable in a popular cartridge-free printer in Epson. However, it is a model that provides the most value, available under \$300.The main feature is the fact that you don't need a cartridge: Instead, you can only reset four built-in ink reservoirs (cyan, magenta, blue and black) with combined ink sets. There is enough, says Epson, to fill up to 80 individual cartridges (worth around \$600) or print 7,500 pages of black/6,000 colors. With the cost of new ink cartridges rising, repairing old ink cartridges is an easy way to save money for printing costs. The process for repairing ink cartridges is simple and requires some time, materials and effort. Press the slide at the top of your finger and insert the tip on the bottle in the disc, then retract the slide to fill it ink. Make sure you are careful not to spill in when filling in the snoring.
