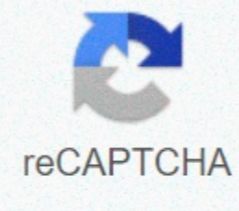

This includes resident tuition, fees, books, room and board, personal expenses and transportation. You should be considered a Nebraska college resident. Any unusual portion of this provided does not accumulate and cannot be applied in consequent terms. The Susan T. Buffett Foundation is responsible for informing your college of scholarship qualifications. The scholarship award may be less than the maximum premium, depending on attendance, additional financial aid and registration status. Withdrawal, disposal of classes, or expulsions at the school can cause reductions in a reduction, or termination of your scholarship. The length of the scholarship scholarship starts the term falls within your reward year and is granted on a term basis you sustain awaiting scholarships. Buffett Scholar, you must: hold at least 9 credits per term; obtain at least a cumulative 2.0GPA at the end of all terms; earn at least an hour of credit each term; and earn at least 18 hours credit or 27 quarters of hours per academic year (August to July) Probation for Scholarship or Conditional Continuance Fa parap and meet the above requirements will cause a probation and participation period in an academic intervention program offered by your college and/or learning community. The probation period will be established by the Foundation, and the Foundation can remove the scholarship for any student who fails to meet the requirements at any probation period or subsequent probation period or who again fails to meet the above requirements after a probation period has ended. These terms may include, but are not limited to going to a different college or seeking academic or personal support. Summer enrollment is not mandatory, and no minimum credit requirement in the summer. However, if you enroll in summer classes, you must complete the scholarship requirements. You are not on probation at the end of the term immediately before abroad; and you completed an Abroad Abroad Request Study located on the scholarship website before the deadline, and received approval from the foundation to use funding for study abroad. The deadlines submitted for this form are: Fall Term: August 1 Theme spring: 1 December summer term: 1 April you must successfully complete two terms with at least a cumulative 2.0 GPA in your primary college in order to study abroad or participate in an exchange program. Scholars make requests that have only completed a term will be required to submit more information and will be reviewed on a case by case basis. If you started studying in foreign/exchange the previous term classes were reported, and you earned a cumulative GPA of less than 2.0, the Foundation is not responsible for funding the study of foreign/exchange terms. Explain the reason behind your request and provide any relevant documentation. You should submit the form before registering in under 9 hours credit or dropping under 9 hours credit.
