Use only one iron for its intended use. 2. To avoid the risk of electric shock, do not immerse the iron in water or other liquids. 3. Always turn the iron OFF before inserting or disconnecting the iron from the electrical outlet. Never pull the cord to disconnect the iron from the electrical outlet; instead, grasp the plug and pull the plug to disconnect the iron. 4. Do not allow the cord to touch hot surfaces. Allow the iron to cool completely before removing the iron. Flush the cord loosely around the iron during storage. 5. It should be sturdy and robust so that you can place the iron on it. The board should be perforated so that the steam can pass through the fibers of fabric softener to soften it and make ironing easier. The lid of the ironing board should also be suitable to allow the flow of steam through. What is the vertical steam function used for? How do I use it? This feature allows you to iron fabrics in situ or on a hanger. To do this, set the iron temperature button to the maximum position. • Leave the item on a hanger and gently pull the fabric with one hand. • Press the steam control button periodically and slide the iron from top to bottom. Because the steam produced is very hot, it softens the fibers and removes the folds. Note: Never use the vertical steam function on an object carried by anyone. Can I get steam on each setting? Yes this is because the steam is generated in a separate area away from the iron soleplate. This allows you to get steam at the lowest heat setting, such as silk. However, when the iron temperature control is set to the lowest setting, you must also set the steam output control dial (depending on the model) to low position, otherwise water droplets may appear in the steam. How can I avoid scratching the soleplate on my iron? To avoid damaging the soleplate, follow this advice: Always place your iron on its heel support or base (depending on the model) • Avoid ironing over abrasive objects (buttons, tensile fasteners, etc.). • Never clean your iron sole with abrasive or metallic pads. How can I avoid shiny marks on fabric? Shiny marks can appear on some fabrics, especially on dark fabrics. We recommend ironing dark clothing from the inside out and using the right temperature. If ironing mixed fiber fabrics, set the temperature for the most fragile fiber. Important: The iron takes longer to cool down than to heat up. We recommend that you start with fabrics to be ironed at a low temperature. What water should I use for ironing? • Tap water: Your appliance has been designed to work with tap water. If your water is very hard (hardness higher than 30°f or 17°dH or 21°e), mix 50% with 50% distilled water (available in stores). In some sea sea salinity in your water may be high. In this case, use only distilled water. • Softener: There are several types of softeners and the water in most of them can be used in the steam generator. But some plasticizers, especially those that use chemicals like salt, can cause white or brown spots. This is especially the case for filter jugs. If you experience this type of problem, we suggest that you try to use untreated tap water or bottled water. • Remember: Never use rainwater, clean demineralized water or pure distilled water from shops, or water containing additives (such as starch, perfume or water from other household appliances). Such additives can affect steam properties and at high temperatures, form deposits in the steam generator chamber, which are likely to stain your laundry and cause premature aging of the appliance. Maintenance and cleaning How do I clean the soleplate? • Durillium sole: Regularly clean the soleplate with a damp, non-metallic washing-up pad. For easier, non-corrosive cleaning of your iron sole, use a damp sponge on the soleplate while it is still hot. If cleaning dirt is a problem, use the stick that is made specifically for cleaning the Durillium soleplate. • The stainless steel soleplate: Clean the soleplate when it is cool with a damp cloth or a non-abrasive sponge. • The autocorrect soleplate: It is recommended that you use a soft damp cloth on the hot soleplate, so as not to damage the surface. Warning: The use of iron cleaners will cause damage to your soleplate's autoclean coating. How do I maintain my steam generator? Before any maintenance, make sure that the appliance is unplugged and that the soleplate, pan and iron rest have cooled down (at least 2 hours after ironing). Do not use any maintenance or descaling product to clean the soleplate or base unit. Never hold the iron or its base unit under a running tap. Cleaning the base unit • Wipe the plastic parts from time to time using a slightly damp soft cloth. Maintain the boiler (once a month) • Note: To extend the efficiency of your boiler and avoid shell deposits, you need to rinse the pan every 10 uses (around once a month). • Check that the generator is cool and has been pulled out for more than 2 hours. • Slowly loosen the boiler cap. If your generator pan has an anti-calcrod, remove it and rinse it under the tap before putting it back in the pan. • Use a jug to fill the pan with tap water until it is 3/4 full. • Shake the base unit gently for a few seconds and then empty it completely over the sink. • For best results, we recommend that you perform this operation once again. If you live in a hard water area, do this more often. Most of all, do not use any descaling products to clean the boiler as they could damage it. How to descale my steam generator? Descaling operation is not for the steam generator, nevertheless, you could rinse the boiler every 10 uses (refer to the user manual). Never use any descaling agent or vinegar when rinsing the pan: they may damage it. • Models with a shell collector. Rinse the collector under water. The next time you use your generator, press the restart button to turn off the orange Anti-calc light (depending on the model). • Models without scale collector: Rinse the pan. Next time you use your generator, press the restart button to turn off the orange Anti-calc light (depending on the model). Technical support Should I be concerned about any noise from my generator? No. When you start or use the steam generator, you may hear a pumping or vibrating noise along with a clicking sound. This is completely normal and is only the pump that injects water into the boiler or the steam valve opening. Why does my orange light keep flashing after I've just rinsed the pan? After rinsing the pan, you need to press and hold the restart button for about 3 seconds to stop the light flashing. Steam escapes from the anti-scale Valve Plug. The antiscalc valve plug can be tightened incorrectly or the seal on the inside of the lid has gone underneath. Is it normal for the steam cord to become hot during ironing? Yes. If you notice that the steam cord is damaged, get it repaired by an authorized service provider. My iron drops. Place the iron temperature control to the type of fabric to be ironed and set the steam output (If the setting temperature control is on Synthetic, the adjustment slider must be on MIN). Some water droplets drip out onto the floor during ironing. That's normal. Your iron generates a lot of steam; this steam condenses on the board. A few drops of water could appear under the ironing board and fall on the floor. Why is my generator not producing steam? If the boiler does not work or the red light on the control panel lights up even though there is still water left in the tank, we suggest that you check that the water tank is not empty. You can also check that the removable water tank (depending on the model) is pressed firmly in place and press the restart button located on the control panel. Even the steam output control dial can be set to minimum (depending on model); therefore turn up the steering wheel to increase the steam. Why does my red water light shine the whole wink? If your red water light flashes, there is no water in the water tank or the tank is not fully or firmly sent down. Why does my generator seem leaking? This may be due to • Trying to use steam before the iron is hot enough. Depending on the model of generator, when ironing at a low temperature, reduce the steam power by adjusting the steam output knob on the control panel. Wait until the iron temperature control lamp is snipped before ironing. • The water may also have condensed into the pipes you are using steam for the first time or if you have not used it for some time. In any case, keep the iron away from the ironing board and press the steam control button until it produces steam. • Overuse of the turbo-steam function may cool down the soleplate. In this case, stop using the turbo-steam function and allow the iron temperature control light to turn off and switch off again before using this function again. • The boiler may be too full. Do not fill it right to the top. Why does steam come from the iron or generator base when it is switched on but the iron is not used? The generator's safety mechanism has been activated. You must have the generator checked by an authorized service agent. Brown stripes come out of the holes in the soleplate and color the laundry. • You use chemical descaling products or additives in the water. You should never put these products in the water tank. If this is the case, contact an approved service centre. • Your laundry has not been rinsed enough or you will iron a new item of clothing before washing it. Make sure you have rinsed your clothes thoroughly to remove soap deposits or chemicals from new garments that may get stuck in the iron. The soleplate is dirty or brown and can stain clothes. • Your iron is too hot, please refer to our temperature control settings recommendations in your product manual. • You use starch. Only spray starch on the back of the fabric to be ironed. The iron does not slide so easily. Some washing knobs and synthetic fibres may stick to the iron surface. Please clean iron's surface. A short time after use, I can hear a metallic sound. The inner parts can make metallic sounds with the temperature change. There's nothing wrong with that. Is it normal to hear a rattling sound from time to time? Yes, this is normal. This is due to the flow of cold water in the pan containing warm water. What should I do if my device doesn't work? No. The pressure is at a relatively low level. Your appliance has two safety systems: • a valve avoids possible overpressure and allows the excess song to escape. • a thermal fuse in the event of overheating in case of failure of the appliance. What is the difference between a steam generator and a steam station? A steam generator is the most powerful generating large amounts of powerful steam in a separate boiler unit and pumps that steam constantly and consistently through the iron soleplate straight into the clothes. The advantage is that this halves your ironing time and provides amazing ironing. A steam station is similar to a regular iron but has a larger water tank. The water is pumped up to the iron and the steam is generated in iron not a separate boiler unit. The steam output is constant but not as powerful as a steam generator. Are lime scale deposits a problem for steam generators? The formation of lime is avoided because the water is not in direct contact with the heating element, which is placed outside the tank. However, the tank should be rinsed after 10 uses to avoid lime scale deposits. Is it dangerous to have the water and electric cables together? No. The two cables are separately insulated; they are protected and carefully controlled. If you notice that the cable is damaged, get it repaired by an approved repair center. What is the ECO setting (dependent models) for? The ECO function allows you to reduce energy consumption. This means that less electricity is used and therefore slightly less steam is generated. What is the function of Autoclean Catalyss ironing plate (according to model)? This system prevents the soleplate from clogging. Its active coating eliminates fibers and impurities that often stick to the plate and ultimately reduces its slide. Where can I dispose of my device at the end of its life?
