He's helping me with the presentation right now, and I'm the one who's rushing into the song. Halpern, a co-star of the Ariel Of Cambridge, Inc., has experienced a cabaret singer who still performs at least once a month. He spends the rest of his time training businesspeople on how to present more efficiently with more emotional communication. We follow your train and admire you for your logic. But because we want to connect with you as a person, we need to see how you feel about things. I approached Halpern for advice on a conversation I had to deliver to 80 people. It was, I realized, a well-structured presentation – so well structured that my audience could accurately plan when to fall asleep. Introduction. Point one. Point 2. Decision. Pass NoDoz. I thought I needed professional help. After listening to me, Halpern agreed. First, she said, I need more animation. Instead of using logic for transitions (Now that you understand my first point, let me turn to my second.) You should use expressive hand gestures and add emotional colors to your face. I'm not suggesting you're inflamed, Halpern advised, but we need to see how you feel about things. So we tried the exercise. Halpern assigned me a theme (of my neighborhood) and asked me to start talking. Every 10 seconds, she called a different emotion – love, hate, humility, happiness – for which I made an expressive transition. (I love people and a sense of history in my neighborhood. I hate it when I find out about the crime in my block.) Halpern made me communicate with a tool that wasn't my voice. If you were deaf - or in the back row - you should know what you're talking about after your speech, she explained. In fact, my vote was the next big challenge. The description of my voice as monotonous assumes that the tone comes first. It was time for another rehearsal involving Shakespeare. Halpern asked me to recite a four-line excerpt from The Tempest, accepting a different voice for each line. Don't be scary (Ethel Merman shouts across the street); The isle is full of noises (the high talker from Seinfeld whispering in your ear), Sounds and sweet airs (James Earl Jones ewning), That give delight and hurt not (Kenneth Branagh playing a king). The idea is, she explained, to stretch your voice in the same way as you stretch the rubber band. It clicks back, but it's more flexible than before when you stretched it. The biggest problem, however, was my unsoud pause – a common presentation error. I would point something out, then cases without the point being submerged. I know that pauses feel like a gargantuan for a while when you're up there. Halpern sympathizes, but for the audience, a few seconds of pause is generous. It says: I think it's important enough to give you a moment to accept it. When I can't stand the silence, she added, I should take care of a few steps down the stage or drink water. Whatever I do, the goal is the same: stop talking. We've finished course with my original presentation. Who would have thought it was so attractive? Introduction. Pause. The fear of the face.
