WHAT'S in the AC power adapter box wireless headphones Top Wireless HeadsetCharging Base Telephone Interface Base Cable and HEADSET BUTTONS At the bottom of the charging base is a microphone and speaker adjustment and an A-G compatibility switch. USING HEADPHONES Now that your headphones are set up, here are some step-by-step instructions on how to use it to make a phone call. STEP 1 Put the headphones on and press the call control button next to the handset. This is the small oblong-shaped button next to the top of the headphones. Press it once to turn on the headphones. STEP 2 Take the phone's handset from the crib and place it on your desk. STEP 3 At this time, you need to listen to a dial tone in the STEP 4 headset Dial the desired phone number and have a conversation normally. Try removing the battery from your headphone handset. Once removed, wait a minute and then reinstall the battery. If the above items 1 and 2 don't work, try removing the battery and undending the power from the wall outlet. Wait a minute, and reinstall the battery, place it in the charging cradle, and then reconnect the AC power adapter to the wall outlet. ECO If you hear echoes when you are on a call, the following steps should help you resolve this condition. Find volume adjustment on your phone. Set this around the midpoint (halfway between high and low). At the bottom of the load base, locate the red dial that has a microphone icon. Set this to number 2. Make sure the microphone tip is about two fingers wide from the corner of your mouth. Having the microphone too close or too far from your mouth can cause sound quality problems. Try resetting your headphones. This is done by removing the battery from the headphone receiver, disconnecting the AC power adapter from the wall outlet and then waiting a minute. Then reinstall the battery, place the headphones in the charging base, and then reconnect the AC power adapter to the power outlet.
