The Review of the Washington Administrative Code requires day care for adults or day care centers that contract with the Department of Social and Health Services, the Area Aging Agency, or another designer of the Department of Medicaid provision for the department's client service to meet specific contractual requirements. A rural ageing agency, elected to provide adult services through the Law on the financing or financing of the care of senior citizens, must have a contract with an adult living centre that meets all administrative and capacity requirements in accordance with WAC 388-71-0736 to 388-71-0774. Adult day care or day care funded by the Elder Citizens Services Act or the financing of reash protection must be the same as the required Medicaid health services or daily health services required under WAC 38871-0704 and 388-71-0706. Day care for adults is a supervised daily program that provides basic services suitable for adults with medical or disabled conditions that do not require the intervention or service of a registered nurse or a licensed rehabilitation therapist acting under the supervision of a client's doctor. Adult Health is a controlled daily programme which, in addition to basic services provided in day care of adults, also provides nursing and rehabilitation services. Adult day health services are only suitable for adults with medical or disabled conditions that require the intervention or services of a registered nurse (RN) or a licensed rehabilitation therapist acting under the supervision of the client's doctor. The parameters for who Can Be Served The Medicaid Program have different eligibility criteria for adult day care on adult day. These criteria indicate the parameters that can be served in these settings. Adult care. Participants in need of the following services may be provided with: (1) personal care services, (2) routine health monitoring by consultation by the RN, (3) general therapeutic activities and (4) supervision and/or protection where necessary for customer safety. Individuals cannot be served if their needs exceed authorised services that can be provided by the adult day care centre or if they are unable to participate safely in group care. Adult health care. Participants aged 18 years and over in need of services: (1) qualified nursing or qualified rehabilitation therapy or (2) personal care. Individuals cannot be served if their needs exceed the range of authorised services that can be provided by an adult day care centre or if they are unable to participate safely in group care. Inspection and monitoring Department or area aging agency or other department holder must determine that day care adult or adult health center meets applicable requirements for adult day care or day care and any additional requirements for contracts with a contract with a COPEs or Medicaid provider. The Rural Ageing Agency or other department designer shall monitor the adult day centre at least once a year to determine further compliance with adult day care and daily health and contract requirements. In addition to RN, the adult day centre may use a licensed practical nurse (LPN), but the LPN must be monitored in accordance with all applicable acts and standards of the nurse. The LPN must valid national credentials and at least one year of valid experience (full-time equivalent), time). Relationships. The ratio must be at least one staff to six participants. The staff counted in the staff-to-participant ratio shall be those who provide direct service to the participants. Where more than one participant is present, there must be at least two staff on the premises, one of which directly supervises the participants. Training requirements should be provided to guide new staff, contractors and volunteers. Staff, contractors and volunteers must be trained in documentation, reporting requirements and general precautions.
