The show takes 12 to 16 contestants (referred to as new comers) with very poor cooking skills through culinary boot camp, earn a prize money of \$25,000 and the Food Network cooking it. In the celebrity edition of the show, the winning celebrity will receive a \$50,000 prize to donate to the charity of their choice. [1] [2] The recruits are trained in a variety of basic cooking techniques, including baking, knife skills, temperature, seasoning and preparation. The ultimate challenge is to cook a restaurant quality, three-course meal with three food critics. On November 24, 2020, it was announced that the 21st season would premiere on January 3, 2021. The last two create a three-course meal to fool a panel of restaurant critics into believing that the meal was created by acclaimed chefs. Recruits twelve chefs competed in the first season of the worst chefs in America. His hometowns and occupations are available on the Food Network's website. Episode 1: Baseline Challenge: 24 of the worst chefs in America were brought to Boot Camp. 45 minutes before the hour, the chef had to cook a dish and who had the worst dishes had to pick up the troops. What the recruits didn't know was that Anne and Beau only pick the 12 worst at boot camp, and they didn't even know that Anne Beau's on the opposing team. Team selection: Beau gives Anne Jenny, Eddie, Hamed, Rachel, Rebecca, and Kelly. Anne gives Beau Sophia, Susie, David, Wilhelmina, Marque, and Jen. Main course: Anne made Tushcan fish stew, while Beau made poached tiger shrimp from the Littleneck Clams, Bok Choy, and Shiitake mushrooms. Each team had an hour to copy their own chef's meal. During the challenge, Hamed, Wilhelmina, Eddie and David all struggled. Hamed forgot to put the mussels on the plate, Eddie overcooked the shrimp and used too much saffron, Wilhelmina's Broth had too much soy sauce, and David spoiled the garnish. Re elimination: After tasting, Rebecca and Marque were named the winners of their own team, and Sophia, Rachel, Jenny, Jen, Kelly, and Susie didn't have the best dishes, but they also didn't have the worst dishes and were considered safe elimination. Hamed and Eddie were the last two in the red team, and Wilhelmina and David are the bottom two of the blue team, but in the end, Hamed and Wilhelmina were sent home. Episode 2: Skill Drill: The chefs make newcomers to Airrang Hibachi Steakhouse to teach them classic knife skills like Julienne and slicing. Season 2: 2011 Casting Season 2 Worst Cooks in America took place at the LA Marriott Burbank Airport, Hotel & Convention Center on March 27, 2010. [7] The Food Network also began accepting online video applications for the second season. [8] The Food Network website announced that Robert Irvine would replace Beau MacMillan for the second season. He made his debut on January 2, 2011. [9] This season, the chefs had eight rookies. Differences between seasons 1 and 2 In the first episode, a group of selected novice chefs made a dish from scratch to give chefs an idea of how bad their skills are. After tasting all the elements, the chefs took turns taking the team members for their rival chef. The first season started with 24 starting chefs, but only the worst 12 were selected for a team. In season two, the first episode began with 16 amateurs, and they all participated in the rest of the episode. In the penultimate episode of the season, the remaining four rookies learned and repeated dessert. After that, in the first season, the recruits had to teach a group of high school students how to replicate the dessert recipe. In the second, the newcomers were left to dessert to serve after both chefs, and enjoyed a special guest main course. After mastering and copying dessert, newcomers had to prepare food for both chefs and surprise guests, usually spouses or other family members. The main courses of the first season were improved versions of the newcomers' audition dinner. The special guests in the second season received what they wanted the students to have. Two newcomers remained for the final episode and had to prepare an appetizer, main course, and dessert with a panel of three food critics. Critics of season one thought the last meal was prepared by chefs until they tasted all the dishes. In season two, critics learned that their food was prepared by newcomers immediately after entering the restaurant. Season 3: 2012 Anne Burrell hosts the third season of Boby Flay, who is replaced by Robert Irvine.
