Northern High School is a high school in the Baltimore City public school system. The school's mascot is Viking. The school's year year is Valhalla. Address is 2201 Pinewood Ave; Baltimore, MD 21214. The school's colors are green and white, but some graduation years also have their own mascots and colors. The school originally had 7-12 classes with a combined middle and high school class in the same building. It opened in September 1965 with grades 7 and 10. Due to the September 1966 overload prediction the classes were grades 8, 10 and 11. September 1967 grades 9, 10, 11 and 12. The first graduation class was in June 1968. In September 1968, classes began with grades 10 in grades 11 and 12. In the 1960s, the university was primarily preparing for university with a high percentage of students entering university. There are also academic programs that work in connection with the school. To promote further integration among black and white students, some black and white students have been bussed from other neighborhoods, helping to make it a more racially diverse school. The city of Baltimore already has a policy that allows students to choose their high school and many blacks choose Northern High School. White students have been given a limited choice. Students take free public buses, help if the school is chosen to stay away. There are several sports teams: Football, basketball, baseball, football, swimming in a 4-lane pool (Division II undying in 1969), cross-country running, athletics, volleyball, tennis, wrestling, gymnastics, soft football and racket. Several community college classes were offered after-school on the northern high school campus. For the 1977 class, the city comptroller, Hyman Pressman, read a poem for graduation. Due to overcrowding in the 1970s in many Baltimore City schools. There are at least 4 years or more starting in the late 60s at Northern High School when students attend the whole year shift, for grade 12 and 12 students attending grades 8 A.M to 2 P.M. with 12th and lower grades initially studying from 10 A.M to 4 P.M. Lunch time is staggered from 10 A.M to 2 P.M allow the school to have classrooms to teach. Beginning september 1968 North The school is a 3-year school. Many students move to northern high schools after middle school in grades 7, 8 and 9. In those freshman times those who wanted to attend the North couldn't and had to wait until their second year due to more crowded. Once enrollment went down to under 2600 students, several extra classrooms were added in casings or trailers, in the summer of 1977, and the school was again full-time. Many students from the morning went directly into the workforce and many in the afternoon session went directly to the university. In 1997, the administration issued a wave of mass suspensions for members of the student body to try to curb disciplinary issues. [1] In 2002, the school system stopped northern high schools and brought Reginald F. Lewis High School and W.E.B. DuBois High School into the old Northern Building.
