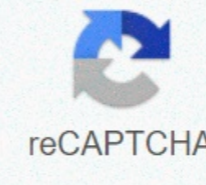

Sec. 6-109. incarceration . No person who owns, shelters or cares for a dangerous dog or other dangerous animal does not allow such an animal to be found together at the site of such a person. A dangerous dog or other dangerous animal is used as this term in this section if it is not such a dog or other animal: b) enclosed outdoors in an enclosed and locked pen or structure on the location of the person described above, provided that the existence of such a pen or structure is permitted by zoning regulations. It is not permitted to keep dangerous dogs or other dangerous animals in areas where such structures or pens are not permitted by zoning regulations. If allowed, such a pen or structure must be at least two lengths of a dog or other animal wide, four lengths of the dog or other animal length and two lengths of the other dog or animal, and should be made with chain link fencing for all four sides and above. If the pen or structure has no bottom to safe sides, the parties must be placed less than one foot in the ground, or have concrete pads for the bottom. The pen or structure must be set back at least ten feet from the nearest line of the property. Sec. 6-110. lying down dangerous animals . No person owning, sheltering or having the care of a dangerous dog or other dangerous animal should allow the dog or other animal to go beyond the place of such a person unless such a dog or other animal is safely leashed, as defined in Section 6-101.
