Tap water (normal household drinking water) is perfectly fine as long as it is free of odours that could alter the taste of the drink. Water is also fine. Do not use chilled or warm water as this could affect the temperature of the drink. Always use fresh water and replace the water if the system has not been used for more than 2 days. For cold drinks use water at ambient temperature, never cooled water water Cube (20g per ice cube) in the cup. To note that water hardness is the first reason for machine calcification and therefore it is recommended to descale the machine frequently (every 3 months or less according to water hardness). Maintenance and cleaning Why should I descale my coffee machine? Scale deposits naturally form in your coffee machine. Regular descaling protects your coffee machine and ensures a longer service life. It will also help to maintain a quality of coffee that remains constant over time. What is the best way to descale or clean my espresso machine? Follow the instructions in your personal manual to descale your machine, as the techniques vary depending on the model you own. We recommend using the manufacturer's descaling product. For a daily average consumption of 4 cups and if the water is hard, we recommend descaling your machine at least every 3 months. If you live in an area where the water is very hard, you may want to descale more often. Does the water tank need to be cleaned? Yes, if it is coated with scale. Clean it with water and/or cleaning agents recommended by the equipment manufacturer. This can prevent blockages in the water outlet and hygiene problems. Technical Support What if there is water or coffee under the device? Make sure that the drip tray is not overflowing and is empty if necessary. Make sure the drip tray is positioned correctly. What if the water doesn't flow? If your device has not been used for several months, the pump may have difficulty restarting the water flow. If you select a small or large cup, the pump makes a lot of noise, but no drops come out.- Remove the capsule if there is one.- Fill the tank to the maximum with hot water (60°C).- Turn on the machine and select the large cup.- Remove the tank and reposition it every 3 seconds.
