Some fans hoped Robert Downey Jr. would get an acting nomination. Meanwhile, others simply advocate for Alan Silvestri's rousing music to get a utteration. But in the end, it's hard to argue with the single Oscar-nomination Avengers: Endgame received. Marvel Studios epic earned an Academy Awards nod for its visual effects. Many of the artists who shaped Avengers: Endgame also worked on previous installments in the Marvel Cinematic Universe. So the recognition feels particularly poignant with this film. After all, Avengers: Endgame plays as a victory lap of everything the MCU has achieved to date. In fact, going back to previous Marvel films gave the visual effects team the chance to tinker. Cast of 'Avengers: Endgame' at world premiere | Jesse Grant/Getty Images for Disney 'Avengers: Endgame' was an epic conclusion to 'Infinity Saga' Eleven years into the MCU, the stakes have never been bigger than they are in Avengers: Endgame. In fact, fans are now left wondering how they could get bigger than the universe itself. For the visual effects artists, it all boiled down to the MCU heroes' face-off against Thanos and his army. That was the key moment, Matt Aitkin, digital VFX supervisor at effects house WETA, recently said. We have to make that shot. And yes, there were technical challenges in pulling it off, but also there was a sense of great responsibility, because even just reading this page in the script, you knew that this whole sequence had the potential to play huge. Like it's just, it's payoff too Saga. You know, it's been an all, it all comes home to roost. Amazing as it may seem that the whole wide shot of the Avengers finally collectively has no actors at all. To achieve this fully computer-generated shot, WETA had to create digital doubles for all 47 MCU heroes included. And that was just the beginning of an intense, complex final battle sequence. The movie ambition presented a challenge for the visual effects team Apart from the big showdown, Avengers: Endgame's Oscar-nominated visual effects team had to answer other big questions. The introduction of the Smart Hulk was the boss among them. Russell Earl, VFX supervisor at Industrial Light & Magic, notes that capturing Mark Ruffalo's performance was part of a much bigger challenge. In fact, Avengers: Endgame, Earl said, involves almost everything they can imagine. [Avengers: Endgame] is filled with digital environments, digital characters, de-aging, old-aging. We go into the quagib, and there are so many things, that it's all these mass explosions, water work. There are such a number of things that I don't think we could have achieved in the time we had without having had the previous films under our belt. ... When we got to playoffs, we were able to really hit the ground running. We had our systems up and in place and it allowed us to just put more time than we normally would have had to get shots under the screen. All the hard work definitely comes across on screen. Even for mcu, an adventure across time and space is much more ambitious than your average Marvel movie. Both audiences and reviewers then got swept up in the film, to the tune of \$2.8 billion. This performance speaks to how effective the visuals are in supporting the story. How 'Avengers: Endgame' changed things in a subtle way While Avengers: Endgame brings many new elements into play, it also stands out from other MCU movies. The main reason is because it introduces time travel. This required the visual effects team to revisit and, in some cases, recreate iconic moments from previous films. The Battle of New York in particular from The Avengers plays a central role. Going back several years on the timeline, the artists upgraded the visuals to today's standards to maintain quality and consistency. Although brushing up an old character can be frustrating, Earl said his team always [wants] to make things better. Aitkin, meanwhile, believes the most significant part of cleaning up older visuals is that fans never realize the difference. From an audience standpoint, they don't even realize that it's changed, he said, because these characters must be recognizable and instantly recognizable. But you just want them to be b'tchin', I suppose. Even the most hardcore fans probably never noticed a difference amid the cheers. So say the visual effects artists earned their Oscar nomination. Avengers: Endgame | Marvel Studios The Marvel Cinematic Universe, affectionately called MCU, has produced 22 films over 10+ years. Now the final film that will make the end of the franchise stage is underway. There is much speculation about what will happen in Avengers: Endgame, especially how superheroes who were dusted by Thanos' snap will be saved. But other questions are much simpler, like how long will the film be? Here's what we know. It's the fourth Avengers film Much of the MCU movies have followed a certain hero, from Iron Man to Captain America. But The Avengers in 2012 showed how the films are all intertwined and the heroes must learn to work together. Avengers: Age of Ultron followed in 2015. The first announcement was that Avengers: Infinity War would be two films, titled Parts 1 and 2. But that was later changed, and Avengers: Infinity War was released in 2018, with a subsequent film due in 2019. The title of the film was not announced for a long time After the separation of the two films in title, no name was given for the fourth (and final) Avengers film. It was then simply referred to as Avengers 4. That's until the first trailer for the film was released in December 2018, revealing the title Avengers: Endgame. Here's how long the movie will run Even before the unveiling of the title, bits of information about Endgame became available. An important discovery in November 2018 was that the driving at that point in the editing process was approximately three hours. Director Joe and Anthony Russo say that's still the case. Marvel probably isn't considering a break With such an epic runtime, Endgame comes in at 20 minutes longer than the current longest-running Marvel film, Infinity War. One Twitter user speculated that this could mean that Marvel would consider adding a break to the film. But both he and most insiders agree that this probably won't happen. A new TV spot during the Super Bowl, a new 30-second trailer arrived in the Playoffs. No new plot details were revealed, but it gave a closer look at where our remaining heroes are at the beginning of the film, which appears to take place at least a year or two after the events of Infinity War. Captain Marvel will save the day Before the endgame, there is still one more Marvel movie to be released. Captain Marvel, starring Brie Larson, will begin playing on March 8, 2019. The film will take place in the 1990s, so it won't mess with the franchise continuity, but there's a very strong possibility that it will connect to Endgame, showing how Captain Marvel will help the Avengers achieve their mission. When avengers: endgame comes out? Less than two months after Captain Marvel, Avengers: Endgame is scheduled to land Theatres.
