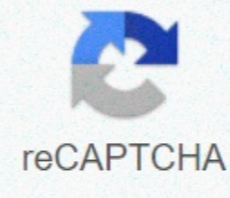

All breast milk and formula, regardless of size, are allowed in your carry-on; You don't even pop it into a quart-size bag. Do you need a few ice packs or frozen gel packs to keep the milk nice and fresh? Absolutely fine, though, they will have to be screened. One caveat: The TSA notes that these liquids are only allowed in reasonable quantities, so if you have a lot, wrap up what you need and then either check or send the rest. These disposable bags, which stands for Safe Tampering Bags, allow you to pack liquid items that you purchased at the airport in a portable device. Just make sure the containers inside are clear, according to USA Today; containers which are opaque, metallic or ceramic are not allowed because their safety cannot be properly checked. When measuring the volume of liquids, the standard one half of a liquid ounce is equal to one tablespoon, while the metric equivalent is 15 millilitres. However, when measuring the mass, one half ounce shall be equal to 15 grams. If dry ingredients are used, one half ounce is the same as three teaspoons, one tablespoon or 14.3 grams. Measuring a small amount of liquid or dry components, measuring spoons are often used. They are usually available in sets that have one quarter of a teaspoon, one-half teaspoon, one teaspoon and one tablespoon. In addition, the tablespoon is almost identical to 15 millilitres. The fraction in recipesVisualizing fractions in recipe portions is easy for some, but may pose a challenge to others. Fractions equal parts of the whole. For example, two thirds or 2/3 means that the whole is divided evenly into 3 or thirds and part of the whole measure 2 out of 3 equal parts. Fractions are entered with the top number, called the numerator, and the lower number called the denominator. Between these upper and lower numbers is a dividing line called vinculum. Converting fractions into decimal placesFor those who have trouble getting a mental picture of fractions in recipes, using a digital kitchen scale is one easy way to deal with the problem. Since kitchen scales do not display fractions, you will first need to convert the fraction to decimal places. So how do you do it? The vinculum or cannon line is located between the numerator and the denominator because fractions represent a division. To get the decimal equivalent of a fraction, divide the numerator by the denominator, resulting in a fraction in decimals. For example, 2/3 or 2 ÷ 3 makes 0.66.To easier to calculate for 2/3 or 0.66 servings of a cup in ounces. Both of these systems have quart measurements that have 2 pints and gallon units that are equivalent to 4 liters. Is it the U.S. or Imperial? One of the common problems encountered by those who are following recipes they find online is figuring out whether the units required by the recipe are customary in the U.S. or in the imperial system. One easy way to determine whether measurements are customary or imperial in the U.S. is to look for a glass of gill measurements. Britons rarely use cups in recipe measurements, while Americans are largely familiar with gills. It's also helpful to note that recipes from the UK are usually weighed rather than measured with shoulder blades. Metric system CupOccasionally, some recipes may indicate a metric cup system.
