Tests to detect yeast infection in males A practical solution to test for a yeast infection is to pay attention to the symptoms, then consult a doctor to have it diagnosed through clinical trials. Otherwise you could go for tests at home, which you can't fully rely on, as they offer inconclusive results. However, you can try such methods before consulting the healthcare professional. Laboratory Testing: There are two types of clinical trials used to detect yeast infection in males. They are microscopic tests and medium culture tests. In microscopic testing, a swab of the affected area is examined under a microscope. A drop potassium chloride solution (10%) is added to the swab, which dissolves skin cells and retains fungal cells. This helps identify candid cells. Another method commonly used for the diagnosis of yeast infection is restructuring. In this method, a culture medium is used to develop colonies out of the sample from the buffer that is incubated. The characteristics of fungal colonies are analyzed to find out the type of fungus that is the causative agent for yeast infection. If a yeast infection is suspected on the skin or nails, the healthcare professional can use a blunt-cut tool to scrape some skin or part of a nail for examination. During this type of testing, you may feel some pressure and some discomfort. Your healthcare professional may be able to tell if you have a yeast infection by simply examining the infected area and looking at the cells under a microscope. If there aren't enough cells to detect an infection, you may need a culture test. During a culture test, the sample cells will be put in a special environment in a laboratory to encourage cell growth. Results are often available within a few days. But some yeast infections grow slowly and it may take weeks to get a result. You do not need special preparations for a yeast test. There is no known risk of having a yeast test. If the results indicate a yeast infection, the healthcare professional may recommend an over-the-counter antifungal medicine or prescribe an Antifungal. Depending on where your infection is, you may need a vaginal suppository, a medicine applied directly to the skin, or a pill. Your healthcare professional will tell you which treatment is best for you. It is important to take all the medicine as prescribed, even if you feel better first.
