A college essay usually gives the word limit directly in a line or in instructions. For example, the University of Illinois says: Explain your interest inside and/or outside the classroom. You may also want to explain how this main one relates to your future career goals. If you are applying for a Faculty of General Studies, explain your academic interests and strengths or your future career goals. You can include any of the courses or areas of study you are currently considering. Limit your response to 300 to 400 words. See, it's right in question, even gave you a range of words to stay in! The shortest word limits for college essays are usually about 200 words (less than half of a single page spaced). You rarely see a word limit higher than about 600 words (on one page with a single spacing). College essays are usually quite short: 200 to 650 words. So if you're writing 300 words into an essay with a 500-word essay ask yourself: is there anything more you can say to expand or support your points? Consult a parent, friend, or teacher where you can work out more details or expand your points. In addition, if the university gives a range of words, you absolutely need to at least hit the bottom end of the range. So if you have a range from the institution, like 400-500 words, you need to write at least 400 words. If you write less, it will come across as you have nothing to say, which is not the impression you want to give. Don't let this sinister hand stop you from writing everything you have to say! What if there is no word limit? Some colleges don't give a word limit. This can be a little stressful, but prompts usually fall into several categories: Sample writing Some colleges don't provide a hard and fast word limit because they want a writing sample from one of the classes. In this case, the word limit would be very restrictive for you in terms of which assignments you choose. For example, for this kind of prompt, check out option B's essay in Amherst: Submit classified paper from a younger or older year that best represents your writing and analytical skills. We are particularly interested in your ability to construct a strictly reasoned, persuasive argument that requires literary, sociological or historical evidence. DO NOT submit a lab report, journal entry, creative sample for writing, or essay in a classroom. Although there is usually no word limit per se, universities sometimes provide general page guidelines for writing samples. In the fag for option B, Amherst explains: There is no hard and fast rule for the official site limit. we anticipate that a paper length of 4-5 pages will provide a sufficient length to demonstrate your analytical capabilities. Slightly longer papers can also be but in most cases it should not exceed 8-10 pages. See, for example, this supplemental wellesley essay prompted: When choosing a college community, you choose a place where you believe you can live, learn, and grow. Generations of inspiring women have developed in the Wellesley community and we want to know what aspects of this community inspire you to consider Wellesley. We know there are over 100 reasons to choose Wellesley, but the Wellesley 100 is a good place to start. Visit Wellesley 100 and let us know, in two well-developed paragraphs, which two elements most attract, inspire or excite you and why. (Not so secret tip: why it matters to us.) There is no page limit or word here, but it is said to respond in two well-developed paragraphs. This gives you an idea of what is reasonable. Well developed certainly means that paragraphs can be long, but even two long paragraphs should not exceed 500 words. What I mean by the implicit word limit, there is a reasonable length you can go to within the limits of the prompt. But what is the right ratio of coffee to a paragraph? Treasure Hunt There is also a classic treasure hunt prompt. No, this is not a hint of treasure hunt. This is a prompt that doesn't have length guidelines, but if you're hunting the rest of the page, you can find length tips. For example, take the University of Chicago provides six Extended Essay Prompts. They are required and you have to choose one, but nowhere on the page there are any hints about the number of words or the limit of pages. However, some Googling about the UChicago essay prompts me to the following information from UChicago (from a now de-existent website): Just ask that the essay is somewhere in the realm of 500-650 words, or about 1-2 pages of single or double spaced (and we're flexible — don't take it as a license to write a 14-page volume, but know it's not 651 words if you need an additional verb). So don't go! You want to (loosely) in the sphere of 500-650 words. Help! There Really Is No Guidance on Length If you really can't find any length guidelines anywhere on the admissions website and you're at a loss, I advise you to call the admissions office. They may not be able to give an exact number (in fact they probably won't), but they probably won't at least be able to tell you how long most essays they see. (I refrain from writing a panicked, 20-page dissertation about a relationship with a dog.) In general, 500 words or so is quite safe for a college essay. This is quite the standard length of the word limit, in fact. (And if you're wondering, it's about a page and a half double-spaced.) 500 words is long enough to develop a basic idea, and while getting a point throughout quickly, it's important when admissions advisers have thousands of essays to read! See? He says 500 words in a tiny font! Last word: How long should a college essay be? The best length of a college essay is usually quite simple: you want to be right under or at the given limit of words. If you exceed the word limit significantly, you risk your essay being cut off by an online application form or that the admissions officer simply won't finish it.
