It was released by Glory Boyz Entertainment and Interscope Records on December 1, 2012. [1] The album features guest appearances by 50 Cent, Wiz Khalifa, Lil Reese, Rick Ross, Young Jeezy, Master P, French Montana and Fat Trel. The album was supported by three successful singles: I Don't Like, Love Sosa and Hate Bein' Sober. After its release, the album was met with consistently positive reviews by most music critics. It debuted at number 29 on the Billboard 200, with sales of 50,000 copies in the first week in the United States. Background Finally Rich was originally intended to be released as a mixtape, but was later converted into a full-length album.
