Just like the sweaters Ms. Weasley made for her children and Harry for Christmas in the first film, this simple sweater is knitted in tweed yarn with initials on the front. The sweater is a main, falling shoulder, with sleeves knitted from the body of a sweater, so there is a minimal seam. And since it is knitted on such a comfortable gauge and secret, this project is great for beginners charming sweaters for the first time. The initials can even be processed in front with a duplicate stitch! The soft and rather luxurious Tweed Cashmere combines with a deliberate cozy sweater: It may have the look of Weasley clothes, but it feels divine! Molly wouldn't do that. How to knit a Weasley sweater in a denknitting of a handmade sweater in a day can look like the impossible work of a speed knitter. I assure you, I'm not a quick Gonzalez when it comes to throwing needles around. With this simple pattern you will also know how to knit a sweater in a day! A few years ago, I came up with this model, which is very simple and quick to make. So this year for Christmas, everyone in my family (children and adults) got these adorable raglan sweaters. Every single person for the person who gets it... It happens that most of my family and friends love the Harry Potter series. Most of them are wearing Weasley sweaters with their initials. However, you can leave the initials or do something else (like a dragon or a car) if you are not a Harry Potter fan. NOTE: An adult-sized sweater will take more than a day to knit! 8-hour sweater is only for sizes 2T - Youth S. There are so many great features for this project: No sewing stitches together when you're done. Do not purl stitches, everything is knitted in a circle. It can be customized with different initials or designs on the front. It only takes a day to do. For sizes 2T - 5T (plus Youth S through Adult 3XL)And (one of my favorite features) this is a super cheap children's gift! This is because it takes only one large skein of yarn for a child's sweater!. Equipment Needed for this project: One set (5 needles) size 7 (4.5mm) double pointed needlesOne small (16-lsh) size 7 round needle (20-lsh) size 7 circular needleChet stitch marker 3XL \$ 9.00Bable for the trolley, having made about 20 of these (no joke), I can testify that this little little sweater really takes only about 8 hours in total only one skein of yarn, so it is very cost-effective. You may already have enough yarn, which makes this a free gift! Any color or type of fiber can be used, I have even made this pattern with stripes. I recommend making sure that the yarn is very soft. Some of the cheaper yarns can be very of course, so just be aware.*Thrifty Trick: If you make the hands long enough, a sweater can fit a child from 6 months to 2 years. Simply wind them until they are too long, then leave them until the child grows. It also saves time and money. If you are a knitter, you can appreciate the absence of purl stitches here... if you are not a knitter, this is a great pattern with which to start. For his birthday, I decided to knit him a sweater, which is a copy of Ron Weasley's sweater. I did it in the colors of Gryffindor, as this is the house Josh (as I said, huge nerds). Anyway, let's get on with it! Yarn I have a soft place for knitted locks. Their yarn is ethical and ethically they are a small business outside the Midwest. Seeing that this is a gift, I bought the more expensive yarn. This yarn is strong, but extremely soft. It's like carrying a pillow. Unlike some yarns, it creates a thick garment with only one thread. This is not their only tweed, so if you are looking for something cheaper, you can find it on their site. HARRY POTTER HOUSE SCARF KNITTING PATTERN PATTERN I used this free pattern. Someone generously posted a pattern of sweater for all ages. There are a few things I would set up or notice about this model. Breast size is not the finished breast size, but rather your current size. The garment will be 2-4 of giving from the chest circumference with which you walk. Looking back, that's obvious now. There is no model letter except H. I took my spreadsheet and tried to make my own letter from there. As you will see in my errors section, this was not the best solution. The pattern uses a lot of knitting slang. Although this is great for beginners, do not take acronyms. Look for them if you're not 15. My mistakes honestly, I want to scrape this sweater and start over. In fact, I direct my mistakes because there are so many! We hope this will help prevent the same. I made this sweater too big. (See the note above for the circumference of the chest.) And the sweater is long. Josh has a long torso, and that's right under his hips. It's not ideal. It's definitely the type of outfit. I added a cord knit as after thought. The original pattern does not include cable knitted edges. Josh asked for them because he didn't want the roll the seam made at the end of the sweater. The reason why this is not good is because the cable knit is canceled! If I had to do it (and probably will) I would use 2x2 tubular voices (here is a video, it's very simple) to prevent the knitted cables from becoming messy. I made the letter using intarsia instead of adding it afterwards. I can save a lot of time and yarn, along with a spare sweater on a strange lump, if I laid it flat and added the letter at the end. That's what I eventually did, but I took the long way to get there. If you use a letter other than letter H, recommended to make the latter instead of intarsia. Closing remarks Are you satisfied with the result? Not. Honestly, I want to scrape it and do it now that I see clearly my fools. If I hadn't made so many mistakes, I'd probably have handled it. Would you recommend a model? To. But I would add my tweaks (it starts with a 2x2 tubular spill for the hem and sleeves, add a letter last, etc.). How long did that take you? If I hadn't screwed up the letter so badly, it would have taken me three weeks between a full-time job and a life. Unfortunately, it took me about 5-6 weeks because of the problem with the letter. What level of skills is needed? This can easily be a sweater for beginners. Any other notes? This will be a great gift for the holidays! Weasley sweater Based on molly weasley sweaters knit for her family every year in the Harry Potter series, this simple and deliberately homemade sweater is knitted in tweedley yarn, with the initials on the front. This model is my own version of the now-print rowan model, which was written in conjunction with Pride and Joy, who created the sweaters for the Harry Potter films. The sweater is simple, drop the design of the shoulder. The front and back are knitted in pieces and sewn together, and the sleeves are knitted by lifting stitches in the holes and knitting down to the cuffs (although the body can be knit in a circle of holes, and the sleeves can also be knitted in the opposite direction, if you prefer to sew them). The initials can be processed in front with intarsia or added later with a duplicate stitch. (For a version of this model in a larger gauge and many other Harry Potter models, take my book, Charmed knit!) Work in stock stitch *until measured 12 (13.5, 15, 16.5, 18, 19.5, 21, 22.5, 24, 25.5, 26.5, 26.5, 27.5, 28.5) inches ending in WS row. Make the shoulders by tying 18 (20, 22, 24, 26, 28, 30, 32, 34, 36, 38, 40, 42, 44) stitches at the beginning of the next two rows. The remaining 24 (26, 28, 30, 32, 34, 36, 38, 40, 42, 44, 46, 48, 50) loops on the holder or scrap yarn for the neck. If you want to assess the shoulders, you can divide the shoulder is connected into two, three or four groups. For example, for the smallest size - tie 9 loops at the beginning of the next 2 rows, 2 times; for the seventh size (32 inch ring.) - tie 10 loops at the beginning of the next two rows, 3 times; for the largest size (44 inch around.) - tie 10 loops at the beginning of the next two rows, 4 times. Mark the beginning of the armhole by measuring 5 (6, 6.5, 6.5, 7, 7.5, 8, 8, 8, 8, 9, 9.5, 10, 10.5, 11, 11.5) inches down from each shoulder edge and pro pros a spare amount of yarn around the seams. Front: Work as for the reverse until part 5 (6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 15, 15, 16, 17) inches below. If you knit the initial one at the front, start working the initial graph with a separate thread from [MC] [CC] for each color section. Be sure to center the graph for its size in the middle of the sweater. If you are going to add later, with a duplicate stitch, continue knitting in room stitch only with [MC] After completing the chart, continue knitting with

[MC] only until 12.75, 14.25, 15.5, 17, 18.5, 20, 21.5, 22.75, 23.75, 24.75, 24.75, 25.75) inches ending in WS row. Make a hole in the neck by knitting first 24 (26, 29, 31, 34, 36, 39, 41, 44, 46, 49, 51, 54, 56) stitches, placing the center 12 (14, 14, 16, 16, 16, 18, 18, 20, 20, 22, 22, 24, 24, 26) loops on the holder or scrap yarn, and the remaining 24 (26, 29, 31, 39, 36, 39, 41, 43, 46, 49, 51, 54, 56) stitches. Continue only on the right side of the neck, work all subsequent neck decreases for this side one stitch of egda as follows: on WS: Purple to the last 3 loops, P2tog, P1 of RS: K1, K2tog, K to the end. **Shape the neck by reducing one stitch on the edge of the neck Each row, 4 (4, 5, 5, 5, 5, 6, 6, 6, 7, 7, 7, 7) times, then each other row, 2 (2, 2, 2, 3, 3, 3, 4, 4, 4, 5) times. Continue in the stabilizer until the front part is as long as back to the beginning of the shoulder shaping (see *) and fill as for the back. Join a new yarn in the armhole edge on the left side to start work left side of the neck. Work all subsequent neck decrease for this side as follows: on RS: Knit to the last 3 loops, SSK, K1 of WS: P1, SSP, P to the end neck of the neck as for the other side (see **). Mark the beginning of the armhole by measuring 5 (6, 6.5, 6.5, 7, 7.5, 8, 8, 8, 8, 9, 9.5, 10, 10.5, 11, 11.5) inches down from each shoulder edge and pro pros a spare amount of yarn around the seams. SLEEVES: Sew the shoulders together. Take and knit 58 (66, 72, 78, 84, 88, 96, 100, 108, 112, 120, 124, 132, 136) stitches around the left armhole from a marked stitch on the front marked stitch on the back. Starting with purl, works in a warehouse for 1 (1, 1, 1, 1, 1.25, 1.25, 1.25, 1.25, 1.5, 1.5, 1.5, 1.5, 1.5, 1.5, 1.5) inches. Start styling the sleeve by working reduced on each side one stitch in from the edge, as follows: on RS: K1, K2tog, knit to the last 3 loops, SSK, K1 of WS: P1, SSP, P to continue 3 loops, P2tog, P1) Work decreases on the next and then every 6 (6, 6, 6, 6, 5, 5, 5, 5, 5, 5, 5, 5, 4, 4, 4, 4, 4) 38 row to 38 (422, 46, 50, 54, 54, 58, 58, 62, 62, 66, 66, 70, 70) remain. When the reductions are complete, continue working in a stock seam until the bag measures 8.5 (9.5, 10.5, 11.5, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 16.5, 17, 17.5, 18, 18.5) inches, then work 2x2 ribs (start and end of each row with K2) for 1.5 (1.5, 1.5, 1.5, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2.5, 2.5, 2.5, 2.5, 2.5) inches. Tie according to a pattern. Repeat for the right hole. NECK: Transfer the remaining 24 (26, 28, 30, 32, 34, 36, 38, 40, 42, 44, 46, 48, 50) stitches from the back stand to a round needle and starting from the right shoulder, knit in the left side of the neck. Take approximately 14 (14, 15, 15, 15, 16, 16, 17, 17, 18, 18, 19, 19, 20, 20) stitches down the left edge of the neck. (Just try to evenly without leaving large gaps. If you get a number somewhere near mine, then that's fine.) Move the remaining 12 (14, 14, 16, 16, 18, 18, 20, 20, 22, 22, 24, 24, 24, 26) stitches on the front side of the holder of the left hand needle and knit. Take approximately 14 (14, 15, 15, 15, 16, 16, 17, 17, 17, 18, 18, 19, 19, 20, 20) stitches along the right edge of the neck. You should have approximately 64 (68, 72, 76, 80, 84, 88, 92, 96, 100, 104, 108, 112, 116) stitches in total for the neck. Work in a circle, knitting all the circles for 1.5 (1.5, 1.5, 1.5, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2.5, 2.5, 2.5, 2.5, 2.5, 2.5) inches and connect freely. Sew the side seams of the body and sleeves and weave at the cuffs. Ach!s sweater! Charts: Click here for charts H. You can also make your own chart with your computer. Print a columner paper (like the one found in Sweaterscapes) and place it back in your printer's paper container. Using a word processor or image editing program, type the letter you want into a font you like and print it on graphic paper on the knitter. Veil - diagram! If you have good image editing software, you can also save and open the paper graphic in image editing, and then type the letter in the paper graphic. Adjust the letter size so that it rises with the squares as much as possible. For both methods, you will want to try several different font sizes to get your letter to be a good size for your sweater.
