Visitors who want to travel from Philadelphia to New York have many transportation options, thanks to planes, trains and buses. Anyone who wants to visit NYC from Philadelphia can do so within one day; however, a weekend getaway or a longer stay is advisable to see all the sights and experience a city that never sleeps. From the famous Central Park to top-notch museums, Broadway shows, concerts, five-star hotels to sports facilities, there's no shortage of attractions to enjoy in the Big Apple. The easiest way to travel between these two historic eastern cities is by train, but those who want a more peaceful and cheaper option can opt for a bus or ride on their own. There are pros and cons of any means of transport. To help you get started planning your New York city tour, we've put on four of the best ways to travel from Philadelphia to New York, including every option. An aerial view of Penn Station on the Manhattan Train is by far the best option if you're looking for a relaxing way to get to New York. The Amtrak Acela Express takes you to the city in just over an hour, departing from philadelphia's beautiful 30th Street station to Penn Station in Manhattan. The Northeast Regional train takes 90 minutes and also departs in the Center of the Big Apple at Penn Station, allowing you to get on the day or start exploring early. Penn Station is a major transport hub with connections to many metro lines and is within walking distance of Madison Square Garden and Times Square. The Acela Express train has only business classes and first, while the regional train has a Coach class with cheaper fares, but still offers comfortable seats with extra legroom. Both trains have a café car and Wi-Fi on board. There are many departures per day, with the earliest train departing at 5:15 to the last at 23:44, making the rail journey between cities convenient. For a more affordable option, consider taking the Philadelphia SEPTA regional line to New Jersey Transit in Trenton, New Jersey to Penn Station in New York. The trip takes at least two hours, with stops and a waiting period between calls, but the fare is much lower compared to Amtrak. In the winter months, taking the train gives you peace and get to your destination without the delays experienced by buses and cars stuck on highways due to ice and snow conditions. Columbus Circle's Manhattan Bus journey may not be as glamorous or convenient as a train trip, but it's the cheapest way to get between the two cities. Buses run regularly from two stations in Philadelphia to New York. Greyhound and PeterPan buses depart from Philadelphia Bus Station at 1001 Filbert Street, while BoltBus and Megabus depart from JFK & N. 30th Street. The bus ride will take two to three hours, depending on traffic and weather conditions, and regular departures take place daily. Bus companies offer online bookings, Wi-Fi and comfortable seating; they even offer onboard entertainment on personal devices. With that in mind, if you prefer to fly, American Airlines provides the largest number of non-stop flights between Philadelphia International Airport and LaGuardia Airport. Often air tickets are cheaper than train tickets. Philadelphia International Airport is a 17-minute drive from the city center and can be reached by local SEPTA train. After landing in Queens, NY, you have several options to get to the city.
