Oxford Companion to Beer's definition of Bottle Sizes for Beer is standardized in most countries around the world, but this was not always the case. The first bottles of beer in the UK often came in sizes known as the renowned comb, equivalent to a dozen of an imperial gallon, 13 ounces of imperial liquid, 378 ml, or the renowned quarter, 26 fl oz. The renowned comb is close to the modern normal size of the US beer bottle, the standard 355ml (US 12 fl oz) long neck. The renowned comb and the famous fourth had largely been replaced in the UK in the early 20th century by bottles in combs and imperial quarters, 568ml and 1136ml respectively. However, stronger wings and barley wines were frequently sold in bottles holding a third of a pint, 6.66 fl oz, known as a nip. In the United States, standard bottle sizes varied between 325 and 385 ml (11 to 13 US fl oz), before being installed at 355 ml. Other beer bottle sizes included division, 6 fl oz from the U.S., for stronger beers. Larger bottles are usually 650 ml (US 22 fl oz). This has become a popular size for American craft beers, as well as the champagne-style 750ml bottle, often with a cork and wirecage. At the other end of the quality spectrum is the infamous 40 oz bottle, which has become almost synonymous with cheap and unpleasant malt spirits, strong beers attached peddled by mass-market brewers. In Canada the standard bottle size is 341 ml (12 Imperial fl oz). After mandatory use of metric units in the UK came into force in 1995, many British brewers used 550ml bottles, although most have switched to a standard 500ml bottle. Smaller bottles in the UK are generally 275ml or, more commonly, 330ml. In Europe, the EU's standardized 330ml bottle is common, although a 300ml bottle is frequently found in the Netherlands. Larger bottles are generally 750ml, and these are particularly popular in Belgium.In Australia's Northern Territory, the Darwin stubby is a 2-litre bottle of beer, originally four imperial pints (2.27 l), sold to capitalise on the region's reputation for beer consumption. Two-litre bottles, with ceramic swing tops, are also found in Germany.Magnums (1.5 l) and occasionally look larger sizes, although these tend to be collector's items or display bottles, usually filled by hand at the brewery.
