Arrowhead Medical Academy ranked fifth on the list, Arrowhead Early College Academy took ninth place and Centennial High School ranked 13th. The three schools were among more than 24,000 public schools reviewed in all 50 states, including the District of Columbia. It's in the ranking criteria: College readiness in the 12th century. College curriculum based on the breadth of proportions 12. Math and reading proficiency, based on student performance, on state-prescribed tests. Math and reading performance, based on whether the performance of state assessments exceeded expectations, given the proportion of underserved students in the school. Underserved student achievement is based on how black, Hispanic and low-income students conducted state assessments compared to those who are not underserved in the state. The graduation rate is based on the proportion of ninth-grade students in 2013-14 who graduated four years later. More: Meet the Class of 2020: Doña Ana County high school seniors in Las Cruces, N.M. public schools have an average math proficiency score of 21% (compared to the New Mexico public school average of 22%), and a reading skill score of 30% (compared to a 29% national average). Schools in Las Cruces have an average ranking of 6/10, which is the top 50% of New Mexico's public schools. Minority enrollment is 81% of the student organization (majority Hispanic), which is more than the New Mexico public school with an average of 77% (majority Hispanic). The 17:1 student-to-teacher ratio is more than the New Mexico public school average of 16:1.
