OSU prefers applicants to have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 and have completed 15 required course areas. Translated students who have graduated from high school and have 36 transferable quarter hours (24 semester hours) from an accredited university or college do not have to submit test results or transcripts in high school. However, they must submit college transcripts and Insight Resume. They must also have a cumulative GPA of 2.25 on transferable credits. Those who graduated from high school in 1997 or later must also meet the foreign language requirement. Students seeking a second bachelor's degree must have a bachelor's degree or its equivalent from a regionally accredited institution, a 2.25 accumulated GPA and submit a statement of objectives and official transcripts from all previously visited colleges/universities. OSU graduate programs have specific admission requirements. In general, graduate applicants must have a four-year baccalaureate degree, professional degree or its equivalent from a regionally accredited institution with a 3.0 minimum GPA or four year degree, a 45-quarter credit equivalent postgraduate degree and a 3.0 GPA.
