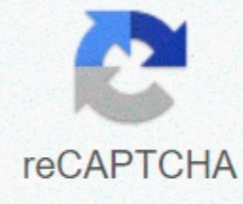

Divided into three sides, the first and third are written from Bella Swan's perspective and the second is written from Jacob Black's perspective. The novel directly follows the events of her previous novel, Eclipse, as Bella and Edward Cullen marry, leaving behind Jacob heartbroken. When Bella faces an un-expected and life-threatening situation, she is willing to risk human life and the possibility of vampire immortality. Meyer finished the book's guideline in 2003, but developed and changed it as he wrote New Moon and Eclipse, although the main and most significant storyline remained unchanged. Little, Brown and company took certain steps to prevent book content from leaking, such as closing forums and message boards to some fans and providing typical email addresses for fans sending linkages to leaks and online spoilers. Breaking Dawn was issued on August 2, 2008 at midnight release parties at more than 4,000 bookstores across the U.S. [1] Of the original print run of 3.7 million naskhah, over 1.3 million were sold in the United States and 20,000 in the UK in the first 24 hours of the book's release, setting a record for first-day sales performance for the Hachette Book Group of the United States. [2] The book was hugely successful, selling over 6 million copies in 2008, and was the third best-selling novel of 2008 behind Twilight and New Moon. Unlike the three previous inclusions, Breaking Dawn received mixed reviews from critics. It is also the most controversial book of the series, as adult themes and concepts are explored more directly than earlier. However, the novel has been awarded the British Book of the Year Award for Children's Books. It is translated into 38 languages with the right to be sold to more than 50 countries. The book has been adapted into a two-part film, with the first part issued on November 18, 2011 and the second part issued on 16 2012. Dawn Breaking plot summary is divided into three separate sections. The first part details Bella's wedding and honeymoon with Edward, whom they spend on the Isle Esme, a private island off the coast of Brazil that is Have. Two weeks into their honeymoon, Bella realized she was pregnant. Because the fetus is part vampire, the condition lasts at an unnaturally accelerated rate. Bella and Edward immediately returned to Forks, Washington, where the fetus continued to grow at abnormal speeds, causing Bella severe physical and emotional distress. The second part of the book is written from the perspective of Jacob Black, an Native American Quileute who, like other members of his tribe, can form a wolf. Knowing Bella's wish to be a vampire, she was immediately suspicious when she came home from a honeymoon and Cullens took care of her father, Charlie, from seeing her. Believing the Cullens had broken their agreement not to bite other humans, he advanced in their intending home to kill Edward. She arrived and found that Bella was undergoing a difficult pregnancy where the fetus drained her life. Jacob begged Bella to derail the fetus to save her life, such as Carlisle, a doctor, or Alice who could see the future, optimism about Bella's prognosis. Despite fears that her pregnancy would be fatal, Bella was determined to pursue it, believing she could last long enough to give birth and then be transformed into a vampire. As wolves are telepathic, they hear Jacob's thoughts about Bella. Fearing Bella would give birth to an uncontrollable, bloody child, they wanted to kill her and the fetus. Jacob received his bloodline as the leader of the real pack to break free of alpha, control of Sam. He went on to warn Cullens that the wolf pack planned to kill Bella. En route to Cullens, Seth Clearwater, a member of the younger pack, also broke down and joined Jacob. He stated that when they formed their own pack, they could no longer hear the thoughts of other wolves. They patrolled Cullens' property and shortly after Leah, a seth sister and lone wolf, joined them. Bella entered labour as the baby began to fight her way out, breaking her body. Edward had to do the cesarean side, saving the baby. As Bella died, Edward injected her venom into her heart. Jacob, believing Bella was already dead, blamed Bella's baby daughter, Renesmee. She went on to kill the baby, and instead the voluntary response imprints in which the form shifter found her soul mate on her. The third part shifted back to Bella's perspective, describing her painful transformation, eventually waking up to find herself turned into a vampire. Fully recovered, she enjoyed a new life and vampire abilities. Renesmee grew rapidly into the toddler, and was seen at a distance by Irina, a vampire from Coven Alas. Identifying her as a child immoral, a human child who was made an uncontrollable vampire, Irina presented her accusations to Volturi banning the creation of the creature. As the largest and most powerful coven, Volturi see Renesmee and Cullens as threats and plots to destroy them. Predicting their arrival, Cullens gathered other vampire tribes from around the world to stand up as witnesses and prove to Volturi that Renesmee was not an immoral child. Jacob's impersonating over Renesmee has forged an unprecedented bond and a joint protective alliance between Cullens and Quileute, ending the hatred between them. When local and foreign vampis arrived, Cullen's home became headquarters and training ground for a diverse vampis and Quileute wolf pack. Having confronted Cullen's gathering allies and witnesses, Volturi found that they were mistaken for Renesmee's identity, and executed Irina in an unsuccessful attempt to insure the full battle. Volturi brought the Cullens alliance with the Quileute wolf and Renesmee's future uncertainty in an attempt to spark hostility, naming it as a possible threat to the secret existence of vampires. Alice and Jasper, who had left before Cullen's allies rally, returned with a Mapuche called Nahuel, a 150-year-old vampire-man hybrid like Renesmee. With her was her biological aunt, Huilen, who explained that her sister fell in love with the vampire and was pregnant with her son, although she died during childbirth. When Nahuel was born, she was a little her aunt and made her immoral. Nahuel proved that hybrids posed a threat, and Volturi agreed to leave Cullens alone. The Cullens and their allies returned to their homes in peace, realizing that Volturi might one day return. When Edward and Bella were alone, she allowed her to read her mind for the first time, sharing her feelings about it. Background Development Originally, Meyer wrote a book entitled Forever Dawn, which is a direct sequel to Twilight. [3] Although the underlying storyline remained the same, Forever Dawn was completely narrated from Bella's point of view, waswolves and Jacob only sketches developed, Victoria and Laurent were both alive, and there were epilogs. [4] Meyer went on to say that he could post some extras someday if I ever had time to go back through the Dawn Forever manuscript-it was only as long as Breaking Dawn. The part that took Meyer the longest time to write Dawn Breaking was half a chapter depicting 3 months after Bella's transformation became a vampire because the amount of time each word put in that piece was probably ten times what was in any other part of the book and Meyer liked to write minutes by minute, but didn't think it would be interesting. [5] Meyer decided to the pregnancy in her story while she was researching vampires, early in 2003, and came across the legendary incubus, a demon that a child's father could have. [4] Bella's insistence not to let her son die inspired by Meyer's reaction when asked whether he would let one of him from him dead so that he can live, that is to deliver the child no matter what the consequences. [6] Meyer said in an interview with Shannon Hale, published in The Twilight Saga: The OfficialLy Illustrated Guide, that the published birth scene was a little less grotesque than she wrote before editing because editors, agents and publisher requests to tone down the violence a little bit. She stated that pregnancy and childbirth Bella, for her, was a way to explore the concept of what gave birth in the past and admitted that they took Bella in a new direction that was not [as] related to many people. [7] On Bella's subject of reliability, Meyer admits that she lost some of her reliability to the character when she became a vampire and said, every point up that point in the [transformation] story I'd say I can step into this story here and I can do everything she can to do that makes it really fun. [8] Meyer wanted to experience Bella's vampiric experience and enjoyed very much writing about them and wanting to finish the book from her perspective,[6] but still thinking it was a little harder because she couldn't step into the story anymore. [8] In relation to Renesmee's unique name, Meyer wrote that he could not call Jennifer or Ashley. What do you name the most unique baby in the world? I looked through a lot of baby name websites. I finally realized that there was no human name going to work for me, so I surrendered to the needs and formed myself. [4] Meyer stated in relation to ending the series: The Twist Saga is really Bella's story, and this is a natural place for her story to wind up. He overcame major obstacles in his path and fought his way to the place he wanted. I guess I can try to extend her story unnaturally, but it won't be interesting enough to make me write. The story requires conflict, and the Bella-based conflict is resolved. [4] Affecting Venetian Merchants and Midsummer Night Dream by William Shakespeare both influenced Dawn Breaking. [9] Meyer decided that Alice would write her instructions to Bella on a page from the Venetian Merchant to hint that the last confrontation at the end of the book would be mentally-non-physical battle—as at the end of the game. It also hinted that the novel would have a happy ending for the pair, as in the Venetian Merchant. Originally it was Jane Eyre's novel by Charlotte Bront that Alice tore the page from, but Jane Eyre had nothing to do with the story, so Meyer changed it. [10] The idea of shrinking, which exists in the Dawn, was inspired by Midsummer Night's Dream. Meyer described it as a miracle setting things right—that didn't happen in the real world, which was really fantasy, and decidedly decided introduced it earlier-in Eclipse-so he didn't have to explain it later. [10] Cover art Meyer described the cover as very meaningful and said that he was really happy with how it turned out. [11] This protection is a metaphor for Bella's progress throughout the series; he started out as the weakest physical player on the board, a pawn, but in the end he became the strongest, queen. [4] The chess board also hinted at the conclusion of a novel where the battle with Volturi was one of disorders and strategies, not physical violence. [12] The Title, Breaking Dawn, is a reference to the beginning of Bella's life as a newborn vampire. [4] Wanting to add a sense of disaster to the title to match the mood of the novel, he called it Breaking Dawn. Another reason to give this particular title book is that it matches the plot of the book, which centers on new revivals and new days and there are also many problems that exist in it. [11] Release Marketing Entertainment Weekly magazine released a quote of Breaking Dawn on May 30, 2008. [13] Stephenie Meyer also revealed the 'Quote of the Day' from Breaking Dawn for about three weeks before the August 2, 2008 release. The first quote was released on Meyer's website on July 12, 2008. [14] The first chapter of Breaking Dawn, Engaged, was released on the special edition of Eclipse. [15] Breaking Dawn was officially released on 2 August 2008 through midnight clearances at more than 4,000 bookstores.[1] mostly involving clothing and trivia competitions, crafts, and facial paintings. [16] Godiva also made a Twilight-themed chocolate bar, released at the Barnes & Noble bookstore on the discharge. [17] The four-city Breaking Dawn Concert Series, featuring Stephenie Meyer and Blue October's Justin Furstenfeld, coincided with the release of the novel. The concert series sold three of its four locations on the day the tickets were sold,[18] selling under an hour in one city. [19] Publications Prior to the release of the novel, the first three Twilight books sold 8.5 million copies across the US[2] and more than 2 million copies in the UK. [20] Breaking Dawn was one of the most anticipated books of 2008 with The Guardian saying Teens around the world were anxiously awaiting the subsequent installment of author Stephenie Meyer's vampiric series of novels. [1] To meet the high demand, Little, Brown Books added an additional 500,000 copies before the title publication, bringing the initial print run to 3.7 million. [2] The book sold 1.3 million copies in the UNITED States[2] and 20,000 copies in the UK in its first 24-hour release,[21] and 100,000 copies in Canada during its first weekend. [22] Breaking Dawn started #1 on the list of 150 best sellers USA Today and has spent more 58 weeks on the list. [23] It is also a in 2008 with more than 6

million copies sold. [24] A special edition of Breaking Dawn was released on August 4, 2009, containing the DVD of the Breaking Dawn Concert Series and interviews with Meyer. [25] Critical Breaking Dawn receptions were mixed. Lev Grossman writes, First, because there are plenty of one-star reviews on Amazon, let me say ahead: I love Breaking Dawn. [26] The way von Wrangel Kinsey of the Journal School Library responded with positive reviews, described the book as charming and alarming, although the novel was darker and more mature than previous titles, Meyer’s twists and turned out not to be out of character. [27] Charlotte observers agreed and called the book pretty dare well, but criticizing the book’s length, says I would like [Stephanie Meyer] not to feel compelled to pack so much into one volume. There should be two books. [28] Mary Harris Russell of the Chicago Tribune also responded with positive reviews and used the book as a fun reading, stating that Stephanie Meyer continued to produce witness writings about family, teenagers and popular culture.[29] while Time called a wild book but satisfying the finish to Bella and Edward’s balls and gave A-ratings. [30] An article in The Daily News Tribune said Breaking Dawn, Some of the dialogue was quite stilled,... but, if you live close to Rich and prodigious Meyer narratives, you may also fall in love with suspension and moving sensitivity. [31] Publisher Weekly states that the main problem with Breaking Dawn is that, Basically, everyone gets everything they want, even if their desire requires about a face in characterisation or introduction of a messy back story. No one should give up anything or suffer more than temporary—in other words, grandeur is out. [32] In an article by The Associated Press, journalist Sara Rose wrote on the NewsOK.com that fans of the series would love interesting characters, great jokes, annoying obsession with beauty, focusing on emotional minutiae; however casual readers may be disappointed with a lot of constructive and little action. [33] The Independent called the book, shockingly, tackily, sick of making sexists and saying that Bella Swan lived to serve the man and suffer. [34] Entertainment Weekly graded Breaking Dawn with D, criticising the unwavering birth scene and passion for Edward Bella and having no other goal. [35] The Washington Post also responded with negative reviews, making comments such as, Meyer has put an interest through the heart of his own beloved creation, and Breaking Dawn has a childbirth sequence that can encourage abstinence throughout the in sensitive type. [36] In an interview with Entertainment Weekly, Meyer responded to the negative responses of many fans to the book and titled it as Rob’s Impression; he said that fans need time to accept the termination of Breaking Dawn, Dawn, because they need time to accept Robert Pattinson played Edward’s role in the film Twilight. [37] The Breaking Dawn award and honor is the recipient of the British Book Award for Children’s Book of the Year. [38] In the Children’s Choice Book Of The Year Awards 2009, the novel was chosen as the Teen’s Choice Book of the Year and Meyer won the Author of the Year award. [39] Film adaptation of the main article: The Twilight Saga: Breaking Dawn - Part 1 and The Twilight Saga: Breaking Dawn - Part 2 Summit Entertainment announced in November 2008 that they had gained the rights to the fourth book in the Stephanie Meyer series, Breaking Dawn. [40] The studio greenereed the adaptation of the Dusk Saga: Breaking Dawn in April 2010. The film is divided into two parts: The first part of the film was released on 18 November 2011,[41] and the second part was released on 16 November 2012. [42] Bill Condon directed both parts: Stephanie Meyer co-produced the film along with Karen Rosenfelt and Wyck Godfrey, [43] In July 2010, Summit announced that the film would be shot in Vancouver, Canada, and Baton Rouge, Louisiana. Maggie Grace played the role of Irina in the film, while Mackenzie Foy played Renesmee, Edward and Bella’s half-vampire, a half-human child. [44] The baby Renesmee is pictured by the robot. It was filmed in Canadian Motion Picture Park Studios (CMPP). The film doesn’t follow the book strictly, as many scenes are created from scratch to add to the tension on the narrative.
