Your Focus – Fighting the True Enemy If I were your enemy, I would disguise myself and manipulate your prospects so that you would focus on the wrong culprit – your husband, your friend, your pain, your finances, anything, or anyone except me. Because when you're in more convenient and obvious places to fight back against your problems, you get the impression that you're fighting for something.
