Your goal is to distill the essence of 50 years of marriage in 4 to 5 minutes; to make the audience laugh, cry a little and reflect. If it seems a little difficult, I understand. © Here's a logical step-by-step process that will guide you through everything you need to do to achieve the impact you want. So take the time you need and follow it. What to put in the 50th anniversary speech? What to put in your 50th wedding anniversary speech: You'll need a touch of anecdotes These are those funny little stories that have become a legend for years to come. They talk about how this couple met and their courtship. Who offered to whom, when and how? Add a little or two of wisdom What is the bonding glue of these two? Family law lawyers Wilkinson and Finkbeiner have put together a sobering page about divorce in the US: 113 facts backed up by statistics. Number 17 of 113 tells us that in 40 years, 67 percent of first marriages end. There is, of course, something special about holding this marriage together. 50 years of partnership is worth celebrating! Recognition and

And sprinkle quotes Recall the usual saying, a poem from a song or poem that has a personal meaning, a verse, or a meaningful quote. (The link will take you to a large eclectic, intercultural collection of wedding poems, quotes and readings, many of which are suitable for 50th anniversary wedding toasty.) Preparing the 50th toast First collect the ingredients. The easiest way to do this is brainstorming, as shown in the image below. Allow yourself at least 15 minutes of uninterrupted, quiet time. In your mind, as live as possible, see the pair you want to write about. Then on a blank sheet of paper and without any thought of order (beginning, middle or end of speech), start writing down ideas when they come to you. (You can open a new document and do it on your computer as well. It just happens to me easier to access ideas with a pen in hand.) Think about the videos in your mind and make them big, multicolored. Now add sound, smell, feelings or taste to bring these memories back to life. It's like making movies in your mind! As any image/thought occurs to note down one word or phrase – just serve as a peg to stick to the idea safely. You will return to it later to detail it in detail if you decide it is wanted. Don't live too long on one idea. Work fast and continue until you run out of ideas, time or paper! Review and correct Now go back to your notes and review them. Get rid of the weak and keep only the best or strongest ideas; making sure that everything you keep matches the tone you want to achieve and is right for your audience. Ask yourself: Did you cover all the areas you wanted? Is there too much on one topic? Or not enough else? Correct until you get the balance you want. Your brainstorming notes can be covered with circles, arrows, and scribed bits. You may even want to do another before you think you're ready to move on. Arranging a golden wedding anniversary speech With notes ready to go you're set for the next step; organising speech. Here you will order the flow of your material. You will decide what is most important. What's next? And what is the relationship between these ideas? Do you see a theme connecting all your material? Get an empty speech outline template to perform If you're relatively new to preparing speeches, it might be helpful to read how to outline speech on my page. This gives a better understanding of how structures, Say. You will be find an empty speech outline template to download. This will guide you through the construction of opening, body and end of speech – ensuring that you get notes in the best and most effective order. You may not need or use all the steps I put into the contour. However, what is absolutely certain is that you will need a basic three-part format: introduction, body and application.
