He was a disciple and successor to Bhagavan Nityananda. [1] He wrote a series of books on the subjects of Kundalini Shakti, Vedanta, and Kashmiri Shavism, including a spiritual autobiography entitled The Game of Consciousness. In honorary style, he is often referred to as Swami Muktananda. Muktananda was born in 1908 near Mangalore in Karnataka State, India, into a wealthy family. His birth name was Krishna Rai. [2] At the age of 15, he met Bhagavan Nityananda, a wandering avadadhoot who profoundly changed his life. [2] After this meeting, Krishna left home and began searching for God's experience. [3] He studied with Siddharudha Swami at Hubli, where he learned Sanskrit, Vedanta, all branches of yoga, and took the initiation of Sannyasa in the order of Sarasvati of Dashanami Sampradiya,[4] taking the name Swami Muktananda. After Siddharudha's death, Muktananda then went to study with a disciple of Siddharudha called Muppinarya Swami at Sri Airani Holematt in the District of Ranebennur Haveri after studying there Swami Muktananda began to wander India on foot, studying with many different saints and gurus. In 1947 Muktananda went to Ganeshpuri to receive the darshan of Bhagavan Nityananda, the saint who originally inspired Muktananda's search for God. He received the shaktipat initiation from him on August 15 of that year. Muktananda often said that his spiritual journey did not really begin until he received shaktipat from the holy man Bhagavan Nityananda. According to his description, it was a profound and sublime experience. [5] Muktananda spent the next nine years living and meditating in a small hut in Yola. He wrote about his meditation experiences related to sadhana and kundalini in his autobiography. In 1956, Bhagavan Nityananda recognized the culmination of Muktananda's spiritual journey and gave him a small piece of land at Ganeshpura, near Bombay, instructing Muktananda to create an ashram there. [6] In the same year he began teaching his way to Siddha Yoga. Between 1970 and 1981, Muktananda did three world tours, siddha yoga ashrams and meditation centers in many countries. In 1975, he founded Siddha Yoga Ashram in Oakland, in the Gulf of California, and in 1979 he founded Shree Nityananda Ashram (now Shree Muktananda Ashram) in the Catskills Mountains, northwest of New York. [7] Muktananda established Gurudev Siddha Peeth as a public trust in India to administer the work there, and founded the SYDA Foundation in the United States to manage global activity Siddha Yoga meditation. [8] He wrote many books; sixteen are still kept in print by SYDA Foundation. In May 1982, Muktananda appointed two successors as joint leaders of the Siddha Yoga Path, Swami Chidvilasananda and her younger brother, Swami Nityananda, who later resigned and formed his own group. Muktananda died in October 1982 and is buried in Ganeshpi, where Gurudev Siddha Sieth ahram houses his samādhi shrine. In 1983, after Muktananda's death, William Rodarmor printed several allegations of physical and sexual abuse in CoEvolution Quarterly, from anonymous devotees who muktananda had regular sex with them. He also charged muktananda engaging in other conduct contrary to broader societal norms. [10] [10] These allegations were confirmed by other CoEvolution Quarterly journalists.[10] while Lis Harris repeated and expanded Rodarmor's claims in an article in The New Yorker (1994). [12] Sarah Caldwell argued that Muktananda was both an enlightened spiritual teacher and a practitioner of The Hakta Tantrism, but also involved in actions that were unethical, legal, or liberating with many disciples. [13] Teaching and practicing his teachings were See God in each other[14] and Honor Your Self. Worship your Self. Meditate on your Self. God dwells in you like you. [14] Muktananda often gave a shorter version of this teaching: God dwells in you like you. [15] According to Lola Williamson, Muktananda was known as a shaktipat guru because the kundalini awakening occurred so easily in his presence. [16] Through Shaktipat Intensives, participants were told to receive the shaktipat initiation, the awakening of Kundalini Shakti who is said to live in a person, and to deepen their practice of Siddha Yoga meditation. [17] Historically, the initiation of the shaktipath was reserved for the few who had done many years of spiritual service and practice; Muktananda offered this initiation to both newcomers and yogis. [18] There are several published accounts describing the receipt of the shaktipat from Muktananda. Paul Zweig wrote such an account of receiving shaktipat from Muktananda. [19] In Gurus of Modern Yoga, Andrea Jain, in her chapter on Muktananda, cites an anonymous source, describing his shaktipat moment, when he was 19 years old, conferred by Muktananda with a peacock feather wand in 1975: I almost jumped when the peacock feathers, firm but with a soft weight, repeatedly hit me on my head , and then gently brushed my face as [Muktananda] [...] heavily pressed one of his fingers into my forehead to a place just between my eyebrows [...] I'm frankly somewhat reluctant to write about what happened next, because I know that whatever I say will inevitably diminish, it will make it sound like and it would have just been another Strong. That wasn't an experience. This was the event of my spiritual life. That was the complete awakening. This wasn't knowing anything, because I just know something that's separate from you. This was: Ultimate - a fountain of Light, a dance, always new source. Total freedom, total joy [...] Completely fulfilled, completely whole, without limits for my power, love and light.
