Summit county jail records ohio

There were a total of 1,583 violent crimes and 14,912 property crimes in Summit County in 2016, the most recent year with a complete set of crime statistics for Ohio county. Compared to the 2012 figures, these represent a 22.1% decrease in violent crime and a 10.8% reduction in property crime in the county. A breakdown of the 2016 violent crime shows that there were 36 murders, 315 violent uprisings, 491 robberies and 741 aggravated assaults. Summit County also recorded 3,401 burglaries, 10,596 thefts, 915 motor vehicle thefts, and 120 arson attacks. The five-year crime trend in the county shows that the number of murders and rapes increased by 33.3 percent and by 23.5 percent. In contrast, there were fewer cases of robbery (25.2%) and aggravated assault (32.3%). Burglaries, theft, car theft and arson fell between 2016 and 2012 by 25.2%, 5.2%, 7.9% and 17.2% respectively. The fee for agencies that are not law enforcement agencies is \$2 while law enforcement agencies can get criminal record checks for free. When requesting an accident or incident report, be sure to call the Sheriff's Office in advance to determine that the record you want is available. Ohio law allows the Attorney General's Office to maintain electronic records of all registered sex offenders who live, work and attend school in the state. To find criminals in Summit county, check the Ohio electronic sex offender registration network (eSORN). Use the search features in the eSORN registry to locate offenders by name, email address, street address, zip code, and phone number. The sheriff is the officer responsible for overseeing the activities of the Summit County Jail and keeping their records. County Jail is at 205 East Crosier Street in and its contact information is the same as the Sheriff's Office. Customers can also receive copies of these items at this location. Available tables are for cases heard from 2002 to the present. To access court documents prepared before 2002, fill in and send public records request online. Whether you obtain records in person or online, the fee for court documents is 10 cents per page for regular copies. The Clerk of Courts charges \$1 per page for certified copies and \$25 per 15 minutes for mail search/copy requests that require IT help. Vital RecordsThe Summit County Domestic Relations Court has jurisdiction over the divorce, dissolution and annulment of marriages and other family relationships. Court records, including divorce decrees, can be found on the website of the County Clerk of Courts. Visit the domestic portal and select one of the Divorce options from the Case Type drop-down menu. The Probate Court of Summit County issues marriage licenses. Office hours for Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday are between 9:00 .m and 3:30 pm.m. Telephone requests are accepted in English and Spanish and are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The SCPH Office of Vital Statistics charges \$22 for each certified copy of a birth or death certificate. Fees are paid in cash, check, and credit/debit cards. Incident and accident reports are public records and can be requested by telephone, by post or in person. If you are going to make an entry in the request we ask that you fill out the request form and post \$1.50 check or mail to be paid to summit county sheriff and it will be processed and sent back to you. If pick up a report in person, please call before you come in to the department to make sure the report is available. You may also click on the link below to get a copy of an accident report electronically. Nominal fees apply. Accident reports are now available online in downloadable form. Information required to search for a report - Last name, report number, Date of loss are mandatory fields to search for reports - \$1.00 fee applies Note: Not all police records are considered a public record. Due to the sensitive nature of some of the information contained in police reports, the Summit County Sheriff's Office is required by law to protect this information. If you can't find a report, or can't access online, you can contact the Summit County Sheriff's Office Records Room at 330-643-2176 or visit us at 205 E. Crosier Street, Akron, Ohio 44311 during normal business hours. We do not disclose the contents of the report over the phone. FINGERPRINTING The Records/ID Bureau provides various fingerprinting services requested by law enforcement agencies, public or private bodies. Applicants for Law Schools, State Liquor Licenses, Explosive Licenses, Securities Licenses, Real Estate Licenses, Salvage Junk Dealers, Auto Salesmen and Applicants for Visas to Travel Out of the Country, Workers in Occupations Involving Care, Custody, Child Control and Are Required under State Law to be fingerprinted for background checks for employment. The Records/ID Bureau offers electronic scanning of fingerprint images and ink roll print services to the public. CRIMINAL RECORDS CHECKS Records/ID Bureau receives requests by phone, by mail and in person from the public and various law enforcement or private agencies to research criminal history files at the Summit County Jail. These requests are from the Detective Bureaus and Patrol Division of Law Enforcement agencies also several federal, state and local governments. We only do background checks if we are your local police agency (Coventry, City of Green, Twinsburg Twp., Northfield Center Twp.). If we are not your local police department, you must go to the jurisdiction where you live and then to the Summit County Clerk of Courts for a county wide background check. The court charges a nominal fee for these checks. End
