

cheol and Choi Gap-won, Real debuted in fourth place on the Gaon Album Chart. [48] The main single, Good Day (Korean: 좋은 날), reunited IU with lyricist Kim Eana and composer Lee Min-soo after Lancinante, with whom she worked again on the singles from her next two studio albums. The song uptempo, as Kim
Eana explains, is about a shy girl who is nervous about expressing her feelings to the boy she loves. During the album's promotional period, IU also topped the charts on M! Countdown, Music Bank and Inkigayo. [51] [52] Kim Eana and Lee Min-soon both considered that the main factors of the song's success were the
use of the word oppa (Korean: 오빠) in the chorus, as well as the three high notes that the IU sings in half-tone increments during the climax of the song. In addition to receiving praise for its vocal abilities, the UI fan base has also expanded to a more diverse population than other K-pop bands, [47] [55] To maintain public
visibility, IU joined the cast of the variety show, Heroes, which aired from July 18, 2010 to May 1, 2011. Speaking fondly of the show, IU remembers despite the hectic two-day filming schedules that allowed them only two-three hours of sleep. Shortly after joining
Heroes. IU was cast in the teen drama Dream High (Korean: 드림하). Filming lasted from December 2010 to February 2011, during which time she committed to Heroes and its existing promotions for Good Day. In her first acting role, IU played Kim Pil-sook, a shy and overweight schoolgirl who dreams of becoming a
professional singer. Admitting that she was dubious about her willingness to act, the IU noted that she would later describe the experience as extremely enjoyable. [24] For the soundtrack of the series, she released the single
Someday, which reached number one on the Gaon Digital Chart in the week of January 30 to February 5, 2011. By the end of 2011, the single had sold 2,209,924 digital copies and was one of the IU's best-selling singles for a soundtrack. [59] An extended game seguel at Real was released on February 16, 2011 with
the title, Real, containing three songs. The main single, Only I Didn't Know 나만 몰랐던야기, was composed by singer-songwriter Yoon Sang wrote the song for IU after spotting his sad momentary expression on a TV show. The tone of the ballad departs from its most recent
outings, with the IU describing it as dark, sad but nostalgic, which is closer to its musical preference. [15] The song performed well commercially, debuting at number one on the Gaon Digital Chart. [62] IU performing at a Disney Channel and Disney Junior launch event in South Korea on June 29, 2011. The IU took on
various secondary projects after the end of Dream High. On March 10, 2011, UI performed the first part of British singer-songwriter Corinne Bailey Rae during her performance of Put Your Records On. Bailey Rae, whom the IU described as her role
model, told the IU: It's amazing that her voice is so soulful even though she's young. The same month, UI was named one of the musical show Inkigayo, a position she held until July 2013. For K.Will's album, My Heart Beating, she starred in two of her music videos alongside Lee Joon and No Min-woo.
[66] In May 2011, UI recorded its first self-composed song, Hold My Hand (Korean: 내 손을 잡아), for the romantic television series The Greatest Love (Korean: 최고의 사랑). [68] Since it was the first time she had written a song not for herself, but at the request of the drama's producers, IU found the experience difficult
because it had to match the joyful tone of the drama. The song reached number two on the Gaon Digital Chart and sold 2.031.787 digital copies in 2011. Itself uparticipated in the I/O Ice skating competitions. Kim Yuna's Kiss and Crv. as a famous contestant until she was eliminated in
the eighth episode. [71] [72] Meanwhile, it has also in Immortal Songs: Singing the Legend, but eventually withdrew after recording an episode due to its overwhelming schedule. [69] IU's second studio album, Last Fantasy, was released on November 29, 2011 in two editions, a regular retail version and a special edition of storybooks, of which only 15,000 copies were produced. The Korea JoongAng Daily described the album as an album that will suit all kinds of musical
tastes and fans, while Billboard noted the album's cinematic sensation as defined by the opening track, Secret (Korean: 비밀). [6] Produced by Jo Yeong-cheol, with whom IU worked on Real, the album contains collaborative works with singer-songwriters such as Yoon Sang, Lee Juck and Ra.D. The total number of
download sales from the album's tracks exceeded 10 million in the first two weeks. Eight of the album's thirteen songs debuted in the top 10 of the Gaon Digital Chart, while the album debuted at number one on the Gaon Album Chart. [78] The main single, You and I (Korean: 너랑 나), became the UI's most popular single
with nearly 5.5 million digital copies sold at the end of 2012. It topped the Gaon Chart and the new Billboard Korea K-Pop Hot 100 at the time of its release of Last Fantasy. IU signed with EMI Music Japan (now part of Universal Music Japan) as a precursor to its entry into the Japanese
market. A selection of his previously released songs was compiled into an extensive game album called IDU which was released in Japan on December 14, 2011. [83] 2012: Japanese debut and first iU solo tour performing at Expo Pop Festival on July 3, 2012. While promotions of Last Fantasy and its main single You
and I continued in 2012 in South Korea, iU began preparations for its debut in Japan by playing two shows at Bunkamura Orchard Hall in Shibuya, Tokyo to an audience of about 4,000 people on January 24, 2012. She performed six songs, including her first single, Lost Child, and the Japanese version of Good Day with
the support of a live orchestra or her own acoustic guitar accompaniment. [27] After the concert, Good Day and I were released as new singles in Japan with lyrics translated for moderate success. According to Japan's Oricon Singles Chart, Good Day's single album sold 21,000 physical copies in the first week
of release, with the single making its debut in the ranking in sixth place. On the Billboard Japan Hot 100, Good Day reached number four on the Oricon Singles Chart and number eleven on the Billboard Japan Hot 100. [87] [88] In support of his Japanese single The IU visited five cities in
Tokyo, Sapporo, Nagoya, Osaka and Fukuoka in a series of mini-concerts entitled IU Friendship Showcase - Spring 2012. IU began its first solo tour, Real Fantasy, in June 2012. She has performed shows in six different cities across South Korea, starting with two shows in Seoul. [90] The opening shows on June 2-3
were sold within 30 minutes of ticket sales on April 17. [91] It was reported that 43.8% of ticket buyers were aged 20 to 29, while 71% were men, which was considered rare for a K-pop concert. The tour continued in Ulsan, Jeonju, Suwon, Busan and Daegu, before returning to Seoul with two encore concerts that ended
on September 23, 2012. Guest artists include Ra.D, Lim Seul-ong and Lee Seung-gi. Due to his commitments to prepare for his fifth Korean extended game album, Spring of a Twenty Year Old (Korean: 스무 살의 봄), which was released on May 11, 2012.
The album, named to celebrate iU turning the Korean age of 20, contains three songs with the main single being Peach (Korean: 복숭아). [94] Self-composed by IU, Peach reached number two on the Gaon Digital Chart and number three on the Billboard K-pop Hot 100. [95] The second single released from the album
was Everybody 하루 끝 End of the Day, which topped the Gaon Digital Chart for two weeks and the Billboard K-pop Hot 100 for four weeks. [3] Instead of the usually accompanies a single release, a 26-minute documentary-style musical was shot in Venice and burano and released
alongside the album, featuring both Peach and Every End of the Day. IU returned to Japan on September 17, 2012 to present a show, entitled IU Friendship Special Concert - Autumn 2012, at the Tokyo International Forum in front of a crowd of more than 5,000 people. With Sunny Hill as a guest, IU performed a mix of
his own songs and covers of Korean and Japanese songs such as Juliet by Shinee, Friend by Anzen Chitai and Aishiteru from Natsume's animated series Book of Friends. [99] The live recordings of Ami and Aishiteru of the event were later released as promotional digital singles. Towards the end of its Real Fantasy tour
and promotions in Japan, the IU resumed its hosting duties on Inkigayo after taking a three-month leave of absence due to concert engagements. [100] She also became the host of MBC's short-lived television quiz show, Quiz Show Q, alongside Park Myeong-su and Sun Bom so. On 29 December, the IU hosted SBS
Gayo Daejeon 2012, an annual music program, alongside Bae Suzy and actor Jung Gyu-woon. She was selected by the show's producer for her mc skills that she demonstrated on Inkigayo. [102] For its achievements over the past year, the IU has won two Seoul Music Awards 2012; Last Fantasy was named Record of
the Year, as one of the ten musical numbers that received the Main Award. At the Korean Music Awards, Good Day was named Musician of the Year (Netizen Vote). [104] Billboard magazine named IU one of the most fashionable musicians under the age of 21
in 2012 for her unique charm and undeniable hits [that] made her a true superstar, [3] 2013; First leading role and modern-day IU at the modern-day IU at the modern-day long the title role in You're the Best, Lee Soon-shin
(Korean: 최고다순신). The 50-episode weekend series ran from March 9 to August 25 on KBS2. His character has been described as a loser who is apparently average in every way except for his bold and brilliant personality, which helps him overcome difficulties. Despite the casting concerns of someone who is better
known as a singer in the role, director Yoon Sung-sik decided to throw IU after seeing his performance in Dream High and thought it suited the image he had envisioned for the character. [106] His co-stars Go Doo-shim and Lee Ji-hoon, as well as the production team, praised his performance, especially in emotional
scenes. [107] [108] As the series progressed, the IU's performance generated positive reviews despite initial reservations about its casting, with ratings peaking at 30.8%. [110] [111] She was nominated for excellence in the Best Actress award (Best Actress in a Serial Drama) at the 2013 KBS Drama Awards. For the
drama, she released a recording with her co-star Jo Jung-suk of her self-composed duet, Beautiful Song (Korean: 예쁘다송), which was not included on the official soundtrack. During the same period, IU released their second long-playing Japanese album, Can You Hear Me?, with his first original Japanese songs. Two
tracks from the album were released as singles; Beautiful Dancer and New World reached 66th and 76th on the Billboard Japan Hot 100 respectively, significantly lower than its Japanese-translated versions of Good Day and You and I, which were the top 10 releases. Rolling Stone Japan gave the album a positive
review, highlighting Beautiful Dancer and Truth as stand-out tracks. In an interview with Oricon, IU recalled how shocked and touched she was to receive Beautiful Dancer and Truth from R and B producers Jimmy Jam and Terry Lewis. His next Japanese single, Afternoon, was released on September 11, 2013, debuting
at number 27 on the Japan Hot 100 chart and number 9 on the Japanese Oricon Daily Chart. [116] Nearly two years after Last Fantasy, IU releases their third studio album, studio, Times, October 8, 2013. It has been described as a big change from the K-pop roots of the young singer who presented a more mature and
sophisticated sound and image than her previous work. IU composed and wrote two of the album's 13 tracks, ranging from swing to jazz styles and the mix of collaborative tracks have been highlighted in reviews for Billboard, The Korea Herald and Seoul
Beats. [2] [120] Billboard described the album as an album that featured vibrations back with a modern twist a back to basics album by La Christina Aguilera, the UI proving to have musical sensibilities well beyond a typical 20-year album. [2] The Korea Herald wrote: ... vintage sounds and modern effects are cleverly
brought together, forming a fresh but familiar compilation of songs. Modern times have a distinct sense of carelessness that is reminiscent of jazz in the Roaring Twenties. Also giving a positive review, Seoul Beats wrote: With its jazzy and big band sound, IU provided a breath of fresh air to the K-pop scene... The real
strength of the album is the way the tracks travel together. [121] Modern Times debuted at number one on the Gaon Album Chart, while seven of his tracks made the gaon Digital Chart's top 10 with the single the Red Shoes (Korean: 분홍신), placing first. [122] [123] Similarly, the album debuted number four on Billboard's
World Albums Chart, with twelve tracks in Korea's K-Pop Hot 100 chart. [124] In the second week of its promotional activities for Modern Times, the UI decided to join the romantic comedy series Bel Ami (Korean: 예쁜남자). [126] She played the eccentric and mischievous role of Kim Bo-tong, a carefree girl in her twenties
who has had an unrequited crush on the male protagonist since high school. The series aired from November 20, 2013 to January 9, 2014 on KBS2 and suffered from low ratings. [127] For her performance, IU was nominated in the outstanding Korean actress category at the 2014 Seoul International Theatre Awards. In
support of Modern Times, the IU held its second series of solo concerts with three shows that took place from November 23 to 24, 2013 at Kyung Hee University's Peace Hall in Seoul and ended on December 1, 2013 at KBS Hall in Busan. Promotions for modern times progressed in 2014 with the IU performing in Hong
Kong for the first time in a solo concert. A reconditioned version of Modern Times, entitled Modern Times - Epilogue, was released on December 20, 2013 with two additional titles: Friday, was originally intended to be included in Modern
Times, but was later released as the lead single for Modern Times - Epilogue. [131] Described as a half-tempo, acoustic swing-pop number, held the top spot on the Billboard Korea K-Pop Hot 100 for two weeks after its release. [81] The main single was a hit on the Gaon Digital Chart, peaking at number one, and
became the 10th best-selling digital single of 2014. [133] His popularity was also demonstrated by his simultaneous number one on Korea's three major music programs without any live performance. [135] 2014: A Flower Bookmark IU at the Melon Music Awards on November 13, 2014. IU released their sixth Korean
album and debut cover album, A Flower Bookmark (Korean: 꽃갈피), on May 16, 2014. The album contains seven interpretations of songs from the 1980s and 1990s with a mix of genres that included ballad, dance, folk and rock. The album was released at the request of fans and due to the positive feedback it had
received previously for its covers. Three tracks debuted in the top 10 of the Gaon Digital Chart the week of its release, with the main single, My Old Story (Korean: 나의 옛날 야기), which eventually peaked at number 2. [138] However, it was his collaboration with Kim Chang-wan on the remake of his 1984 track, The
Meaning of You (Korean: 너의 의미), that became the album's best-selling track and also his best-selling single of 2014. [140] The album was well received by the Korea Times for providing a pleasant and soothing respite from today's mainstream music, and praised IU for its reinterpretations: For each song, UI maintains
a careful balance between preserving the original feelings of the song and modifying the original with its own color and arrangements. Billboard referred to Pierrot Smiles at Us 삐에로는 우릴 보고 웃지 as the most ambitious tune she approaches and which proves her diversity as a singer. In addition, A Flower Bookmark
was nominated for Billboard's third best K-Pop album in 2014 and was nominated for album of the year at the 2014 MelOn Music Awards. [142] The IU's desire to conduct a more intimate and smaller-scale concert was fulfilled in its third korean solo concert series, Just One Step... It's a lot more. The eight-night concert
series ran from May 22, 2014 to June 1, 2014, at sogang University's Mary Hall, with a capacity of 450 people. [145] Tickets for all eight shows were sold out within 10 minutes of release on May 7, 2014. In addition to playing the keyboard for the first time on stage, IU performed the seven songs of A Flower Bookmark
among various new arrangements of his earlier songs. Kim Jong-hyun, Jung Yong-hwa, Hwang Kwanghee, Kim Bum-soo, Lim Seul-ong, Jo Jung-suk, Ha Dong-kyun and Akdong Musician. The profits from the concerts are to the victims of the Sewol ferry disaster. [147] Two months after his solo solo ended, IU made its
first performance in the United States at the KCON music festival held in Los Angeles from August 9 to 10. IU is the only woman to performed The Red Shoes, You and I, Friday and You Know. [148] In their review, the Los Angeles Times opined that the UI had a
scary stage presence, and as a solo singer, she broke the molds for K-pop fame. [149] The 2014 KCON event was attended by approximately 42,000 people. [150] IU expressed his anxiety while playing at the event in his interview with Billboard: I'm always nervous when I play international shows ... I think I need to
study English for the next visit to the United States. It's stifling not being able to communicate with the fans... [151] Throughout 2014, IU's collaborations with other artists spawned top-not 10 hits: Not Spring, Love, or Cherry Blossoms (Korean: 봄, 사랑, 벚꽃 말고), High4's first single, which featured IU as a lyricist and
singer, reached number one on the Gaon Digital Chart and Billboard Korea's K-Pop Hot 100; [11] Anxious Heart (Korean: 애타는 마음), recorded by Ulala Session and IU in 2012, was released more than a year later out of respect for the death of the Ulala Session singer, peaking at fourth place on the Gaon Digital Chart;
[153] Sing for Me (Korean: 노래 불러줘요), released as part of God's eighth studio album, reached ninth place on the Gaon Digital Chart; [157] When
Would It Be (Korean: 언제쯤면), a duet with his label Yoon Hyun-sang for his debut album, Pianoforte, also reached the ninth place of the Gaon Digital Chart. [159] After Not Spring, Love, or Cherry Blossoms topped Billboard's Korea K-Pop Hot 100 chart, IU became its all-time leader with five number one songs and the
artist who spent the most weeks at the top of the chart since the chart was created in September 2011. [11] 2015-2016: Continuous success of actor and other ep releases UI during his Chat-Shire concert on November 29, 2015. In 2015, two years after her last acting role, UI starred alongside Kim so-hyun, Cha Tae-
hyun and Gong Hyo-jin in The Producers (Korean: 프로듀사), which was named as one of the most anticipated television series of the year in South Korea. [161] She played Cindy, a diva-like singer who decides to participate in a variety show to improve her public image. Analysing the perceived icy behaviour of her
character, the IU noted that she relate to the biting attitude of her character and the similarity of her character to herself. [161] The series and the Ul's portrayal of Cindy were greeted with lukewarm reviews but audience and critical response improved over the course of the series, peaking at 17.7% audience for the last
episode. [162] [163] She performed two songs in the character, Twenty Three and Heart (Korean: 마음), both of which were later included as bonus tracks on her 2015 album, Chat-Shire. Although she wrote the lyrics to both songs, she also composed the music for Heart, which was released as a digital single on May
18. Heart topped the charts when it was released and became the tenth best-selling digital single of 2015 in South Korea. [164] Heart is one of a slew of k-pop songs used by the South Korea.
August 2015, with the aim of advertising the culture of South Korean youth. [166] [167] Through producers, the popularity of the IU in China has skyrocketed- apparently receiving offers for several Chinese business projects. After the completion of The Producers, the UI participated in the biennial music festival event
organized by the variety show Infinite Challenge, in which each participating singer-songwriter was associated with one of the festival event were broadcast over seven episodes. She teamed up with Park Myeong-su, with whom she recorded
and performed the song Leon (inspired by the film Leon: The Professional). The live performance event on August 13, 2015 drew an estimated crowd of 40,000 to Alpensia Ski Jumping Stadium as shown in the latest episode, which reached a 21.1% viewer rating on its August 22, 2015 airdate. After the last episode
aired, Leon was released with the other songs from the festival as a digital track and on the festival's official album. Leon reached number one on all South Korean music charts when it was released. IU's seventh Korean album, Chat-Shire, was released digitally on October 23, 2015 before its physical release on October
27, 2015. The UI asserted greater creative control over the album, writing the lyrics to the seven tracks (as well as the two bonus tracks individually or in collaboration. She was also credited as the album's executive producer. [171] The main single, Twenty-
Three (Korean: 스물셋), topped the national music charts when it was released with several tracks from the album also making the top 10. The album reached number four on the World Albums chart. Billboard describes the album as a must-have album, Some of the most personal music [of IU] to date and named The
Shower (Korean: 푸르던) as his stand-out track. [6] Seoul Beats also highlighted the personal quality highlighted in many of the album's tracks and UI's increasing maturity as an artist and its willingness to experiment musically. [173] [174] IU at the 24 Steps - One, Two, Three, Four concert on December 3, 2016. Despite
positive reviews and success in the music charts, the album became controversial due to the lyrics of Zezé and the audio samples used in the single lead titled in the same way). [175] On November 4, the Korean publisher of the novel My Sweet Orange Tree,
whose UI was inspired by the song Zezé, sparked a debate in the entertainment industry about freedom of interpretation when he criticized the IU for its portrayal of the five-year-old protagonist as a sexual object... but I
realize that my words have offended many, and for that I apologize. On November 10, the publisher apologized for not recognizing the diversity of interpretation. [176] For the bonus title Twenty Three, vocal samples of Britney Spears' Gimme More were reportedly used without permission. Billboard ranked Chat-Shire as
the sixth best K-pop album of 2015, explaining that IU knows how to take vesterday's sounds and update them to stunning results, [179] Prior to the release of Chat-Shire, LOEN announced that the UI would not participate in the album's broadcast promotions and instead organized a national tour from November to
December 2015. The Chat-Shire national tour began in Seoul on November 21 and continued in Busan, Daegu and Gwangju, before returning to Seoul, where it ended on December 31. [181] In the midst of its concert tour for Chat-Shire in South Korea, the IU also expanded its promotional activities in Hong Kong, China
and Taiwan, hosting fan meetings and concerts in various cities, as well as the release of a compilation album, Smash Hits, on the Taiwanese market on December 11, 2015. [183] Featuring 16 previously released songs, Smash Hits was released by Warner Music Taiwan and topped the K-pop album charts at Taiwan's
first online music store, KKBOX, in its first week of release. Tickets for his January 10, 2016 concert in Taiwan also sold out within two minutes of its sale. Towards the end of 2015, the IU hosted SBS's annual end-of-year music program, Gayo Daejeon, with Shin Dong-yup. The show's producers said on behalf of their
selection of hosts: The IU has been deeply recognized for its musical talents, beyond the image of the gretty younger sister of Korea named her Woman of the Year. [187] In September 2016, the IU played the lead role, Hae soo, in Moon
Lovers: Scarlet Heart Ryeo, a Korean adaptation of the Chinese novel Bu Bu Jing Jing 2017-2018: Palette, A Flower Bookmark 2 and My Mister IU at its Palette concert in Seoul, South Korea, December 10, 2017. IU released her fourth studio album, Palette, on April 21, 2017, of which she was the main lyricist and
executive producer. [191] [192] Three singles from the album were released earlier; the single of the same name with Big Bang's G-Dragon; [193] as well as two pre-release tracks Through the Night and Can't Love You Anymore. [194] Palette debuted at the top of the Billboard World Albums chart (a first for the singler)
[196] and topped the local charts in album sales and downloads. [197] Billboard highlighted and complimented the IU's stronger creative control over the album, claiming that it allowed listeners to learn more about her and ultimately pave the way for greater success in Korea and abroad. Palette was a commercial
success, with the album's three singles topped the Gaon Digital Chart with the lead single, Palette spending a total of two weeks at number 1. However, it was his first pre-release track, Through the Night that became the album's best-selling track and also his best-selling single of 2017. Palette was also critically
acclaimed and received numerous awards, including Best Pop Album at the 15th Korean Music Awards, [202] Album of the Year (Album) at the 27th Seoul Music Awards; IU herself received the award for Best Female Artist at the Mnet Asian Music Awards. [205]
The album also won IU a Best Songwriter at the Melon Music Awards, [203] a lyricist of the year at the 7th Gaon Chart Music Awards for its hit song Through the Night.
[207] Billboard magazine ranked Palette at number six on its list of Best K-Pop Songs of 2017, explaining The mellow-dy denies a topsy-turvy world of self-satire, idiosyncratic sound effects and returns to earlier eras. The New York Times Magazine also featured Palette on its list of 25 Songs That Tell Us Where Music
Goes, making the UI the only Asian artist to make the list while appreciating the UI's ability as a singer-songwriter to project authenticity into K-pop. [209] In addition, Billboard ranked Palette as the best K-pop album of 2017, explaining that an album as impressive and diverse as Palette proves why injecting an artist's
personal experiences into his music can lead to his greatest work to date. Palette's promotional period, UI joined the hyori's Homestay reality program. IU released their second cover album, A Flower Bookmark 2, on September 22, 2017. Like its predecessor, the album contained interpretations tracks released from the
1960s to the early 2000s with a mix of genres such as folk, retro, ballad and nu-disco. [212] Prior to the release of the album, a single entitled Autumn Morning was released without notice on September 18 to mark the singer's ninth birthday. [214] It topped the seven local music charts when it was released. [216] The
album was originally intended to include Kim Kwang-seok's title With the Heart to Forget You, however, due to recent events surrounding the singer's family, it was eventually decided that the song would be removed out of respect for ongoing investigations. She later toured various cities in Korea and Hong Kong from
November to December 2017 to promote the album. IU is also featured in the title track Love Story from Epik High's ninth album, We've Done Something Wonderful, released on October 23, 2017. The song performed a Perfect All-Kill, topped the daily and real-time charts of the 6 major Korean music sites. Gallup Korean music sites.
ranked her the most popular K-pop artist of 2017 (she was already at the top of the charts in 2014) and also the most popular k-pop idol of the year. [12] In March 2018, IU starred in TVN's My Mister, playing the character of Lee Ji-an. [221] The series enjoyed commercial and critical success with ratings of 7.3%, making
it one of the highest-rated Korean dramas in cable television history, and positive reviews for the IU's performance. [222] IU then contributed his voice to Zico's Soulmate, released on July 23, 2018.
