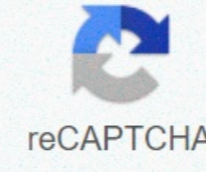

Job market: Unemployment and travel time were taken into account using data from the Bureau of Safety survey. Violent crime rates and property were measured and ranked with data from the FBI. Educational achievement: We used data from the Bureau of Labor Statistics to get a sense of a city's educational ate. In addition, we look at the net migration of each region and the speed of its development, according to government data. Keep in mind that these are larger cities statewide. There may be smaller towns around the big cities on this list that are more attractive places to live for your situation, but this list may serve as a starting point.
