## Michigan enhanced license real id

Beginning Oct. 1, 2021, all Michigan residents will need a real ID license to fly within the United States and enter certain federal facilities under federal law. You can tell if your license is fulfillful by looking at your driver's license or state identification card. REAL ID will have a star in a gold circle printed on it or the American flag if you have an enhanced license. Improved licenses and IDs do not need to be updated. How to apply for the REAL ID To apply for a compliant driver's license or state identification card, you must bring your valid U.S. passport or certified birth certificate with an elevated seal or stamp to any secretary of the state office. You can also use another document to verify your identity of the Michigan Secretary of State accepted documents list. How much does a REAL ID cost? There is no additional charge for a GENUINE ID compliant license or state identification card when a person usually renews. Applying for a compliant license before your current license expires will result in a correction fee. If your license renews to Oct. 1, 2021, and you choose not to get a REAL ID, it will still be valid. You can always use it as valid identification for cash checks, purchasing alcohol, or importing casinos. But you will need to have an approved, compliant document when flying on a plane or importing federal buildings because your standard license will not be accepted. What happens if you don't get a TRUE ID if your driver's license or state ID card isn't REAL ID-compliant, you must show a different form of acceptable documentation, such as a valid U.S. passport or passport card. The Transportation Security Administration published a list of accepted documents. Here's what you need to know about them: • These forms of identification comply with federal regulations and leave a person on board a domestic flight, or enter a federal building, nuclear plant or military base, without taking a passport or other accepted document. • Starting on October 1, 2020, standard licenses and IDs - which do not meet REAL ID-compliant - will not be acceptable to these uses, which other documentation. • ACTUAL ID-compliant licenses and IDs will no longer cost as standard licenses and will be marked with a star in the upper right corner. • Unlike an improved driver's license (see below for details), ACTUAL ID-compliant licenses and IDs will not contain a radio frequency identification (RFID) chip. • According to the Secretary of State: Michigan residents must check their license or ID card renewal notice when it comes in the mail for information on whether they have already complied with actual ID identification requirements. To obtain a compliant card, residents will have to bring a certified birth certificate or another approved document to any secretary of the state office. According to the Secretary of State: The improved driver's license is a cost-effective and convenient document that meets driving, identification and border crossing needs. This is a federally approved document that allows you to re-enter the U.S. when traveling through land or sea of Canada, Mexico, Bermuda and the Caribbean. While not required, the improved licence is an excellent alternative to a standard licence because it is especially handy for business trips, holidays or quick trips. How does an improved license differ from a standard license? According to the Secretary of State: All driver's licenses and state ID cards issued by the Secretary of State use security features that are best practices in the industry to prevent the card from being fraudulently copied or used. Specific features of the enhanced license or ID include: a. A radio frequency identification (RFID) chip to speed up border crossings. The RFID chip does not contain any personally identifying information. B. A machine-readable zone at the back of the map to serve as a backup if RFID equipment is not available. c. A security queue to protect the RFID chip from being read when the card is not in use. d. An image of an American flag on the front indicating American citizenship. E. The word Improves on the front. Your first improved license would cost \$45, with renewals (every four years) costing \$38, while a standard license costs \$25 originally and \$18 to renew. How do I get an improved license? A visit to a secretary of state must upgrade to an improved license – upgrading online or by email is not yet available. You will want to bring: • Your Social Security Card • Proof of citizenship (such as your birth certificate) • Proof of identity and residency (such as your current licence) From there it simply has to be a matter of getting your picture taken and paying the fee. The improved version of your license should come by email in 2-3 weeks.
