Battle of the Labyrinth is the fourth book by Percy Jackson and the Olympic series written by Rick Riordan. The story tells of AnnaBeth Chase as she leads her friends in search of the infamous labyrinthine inventor as they discover his role in a dark plot against the camp by Kronos' army. Orientation Plot School begins with Percy Jackson going to a first-year orientation class at Goode High School, a school where Paul Blofis, his mom's boyfriend, teaches. While there, he meets Rachel Elizabeth Dyer, a clear-sighted mortal whom he once met at Hoover Dam at the Curse of the Titans. During orientation, Rachel suddenly flees to the gym. Percy follows her, and she tells him there's something wrong with the two cheerleaders, Tammy and Kelly. The people in question enter the gym where they reveal themselves to be empousai. Percy kills Tammy, but Kelly disappears in a burst of fire. Unfortunately, Paul Bluepeace and several other mortals see the incident forcing Percy and Rachel to escape through a broken window. They're both running out to where AnnaBeth is waiting. Rachel leaves Percy, tells him to explain everything when he has time. Then, Percy, along with AnnaBeth, makes their way to camp. After arriving at the camp, AnnaBeth decides to go talk to Clarice Le Roux about something secret, leaving Percy to roam the camp alone. He stops at the scene and sees a giant hellhound, Mrs. O'Leary. He tries to kill her, but is soon arrested by Quintus, the new sword lord, who discovers That Mrs. O'Leary is his pet. Kyron interrupts their conversation and takes Percy to Grover Underwood. He leads them to the seafly where the Council of Elders of Kloben is held and knocks him down next to AnnaBeth, Clarice and a crying nymph, Juniper, who turns out to be Grover's girlfriend. Mrs. O'Leary. The council decides that Grover has only one week to find Penn, the god of lost nature. Otherwise, his seeker's license will be removed. The meeting ends, and Perry rushes to clean his cabin for cell inspection. As soon as he got to the Poseidon cabin, he sees his half-brother, Tyson, cleaning up. Tyson hugs him and shows him the repaired shield he broke last winter during the battle with the Manticores. Later that night, Percy struggles to sleep. He realizes the room glows with a faint blue light coming from the saltwater fountain his father gave him last winter. There's rainbow light around it, obviously Iris's message. He deposits one dracama into the mist, and he shimmers until Nico Di Angelo's character becomes clear. Nico talks to Asking if there's any way to bring Bianca Di Angelo back to life. Poseidon tells Percy that he's his beloved son and gives him a dollar of sand before he leaves. Nico suddenly appears, claiming he's found a way to beat Kronos. Percy notes how Nico looks sadly at the birthday food and invites him in for both food and speech.
