Whether you need to get a learner's license before applying for a standard license, most depend on where you live and whether you have a driving experience. For example, first-time drivers over 18 in Delaware are required to hold a learner's license for at least 10 days before they can take a road test for a standard license. In Virginia, first-time drivers aged 19 and over must hold a learner's license for at least 60 days or successfully pass a driver's education course before being allowed to take a road skill test for a standard license. Virginia drivers under the age of 19 must have a learner's license for at least nine months and pass the driver's education course before they can apply. Many states do not require first-time drivers to obtain a learner's license first. But they will have to meet additional requirements. For example, every candidate in New Hampshire must submit two forms of identification application and proof of residence, pay a fee and pass a vision test. Those who have never held a driver's license must succeed in the knowledge and road tests. First-time drivers under the age of 18 must complete a driver's education course and record a supervised driving time of 40 hours before they can apply for a standard licence. If a person already has a license and moves to another state, he usually does not need to obtain a learner's license in the new state first. Instead, he filed a license application at the Local Department of Motor Vehicles. Typically, he surrendered his previous license, gave his Social Security number and fingerprints, pose for photos, submit proof of identity, age, local address and citizenship status, and pay a fee. Additional requirements may include vision tests, knowledge exams and successful road skills tests. Foreign citizens with valid foreign driver's licenses are often not required to obtain a learner's license before obtaining a license in the state or territory of residence of the United States. The first driver's license was issued in 1903 by Massachusetts and Missouri. These do not require a verification of driving skills and are a little more than an ID card. In the late 1930s and 1940s, many states ordered potential drivers to pay a small fee of 25 or 50 cents in exchange for a driver's license, often by mail. Safety concerns began urging the state to issue pre-driver-license checks. This was partly due to an increase in the number of cars and drivers. In 1907, the New York Times published an article titled Better Automated Laws, which reported concerns to leading car experts about accidents caused by driver experience and negligence. In 1908, Rhode Island became the first state to test individuals on their driving skills before issuing licenses. In 1913, the New York Times issued a report that New Jersey requires all drivers to pass driving capability checks and written tests in the hope that other states will follow New Jersey's leadership to reduce the number of accidents. Although exams were not required in Washington state until 1937, when the state A driver's license in 1921 required two signatures to ensure that applicants could drive safely.
