The album's second song, Love Is Strong a Justice (The Unifcent Seven), was chosen as a tribute to the films Seven Samurai and The Magnificent Seven. According to the interview disc, the idea came to Sting when he wanted to write a song to 7/4 beats. The song Seven Days has also been noted for his polished performances with Vinny Coràuta and 5/4 time signatures. The international exclusive track Everyone Laughed, But You was excluded from the Canadian and American press for the album. However, the album's American single included a version of the song with different lyrics: Star of January. The single in 10 Samoner's story also gives credit to Fernandez Guitars, just as Dominic Miller played the Fernandez P Project Acoustic Electric Nylon Guitar throughout the album. Re-released in 1998, Ten Summoners Tales was remastered and re-released in 1998. Problems with the new CD included a bonus video track for If I Lose My Faith in You. It also featured the song Everyone Laughed, But You Did, which was excluded from the original 1993 release in the U.S. and Canada. He appeared in original releases in the UK, Europe, Japan and elsewhere, and appeared in the single If I Lose Faith in You. The instrumental track for Everybody Laughed, But You was also used in another lyric, released as The Star of January with the singles Seven Days and If I Lose My Faith in You.
