Like many Mesoamerican, Tzolk'in, or Sacred Round calendars, the calendar operates on a 260-day cycle. One hypothesis for the significance of its cycle length is that 260 days is associated with pregnancy [source: Maya Mystery School]. A proposal that the calendar represents the length of time it takes to grow maize. However, it is most likely based on Mayer's reverence for the numbers 13 and 20. In the Gregorian calendar, we have seven days a week and, depending on the month, anywhere from 28 to 31 days. The Tzolk'in calendar is made up of a set of 20-day names, symbolized by images called glyphs and 13 digits called tones. Dates are numbered from one to 13, and names are also given in order. The Tzolk'in calendar start with the first date name, Imix', and number one. The days continue in order, with the second day being a combination of Ik' and number two; names and days combine in order until all 13 tones are used. Once the calendar reaches the 13th, signed by B'en and number 13, the numbers start again with one, but the date name moves forward with the 14th glyph, Ix. By rotating like this, two sets form 260 unique combinations of a date name and a number. For example, once you reach the end of the cycle of the date name with 7 Ajaw, the date name starts again at Imix, and the digits continue: 8 Imix', 9 Ik', 10 Ak'b'al and so on. This content is not compatible on this device. Think of two nested gears, with 13 digits spaced around a smaller round cake that matches the inside of the larger cake of the date name shown in the graph. If you lock the gears together at number one and name on Imix', then rotate the gears until you reach one and Imix' again, you will get 260 days only. These gears rotate until the final combination clicks on the position at 13 Ajaw, marking the end of the year. It's easy to see the importance the Maya people place in the Tzolk'in calendar. For example, they believe that your date of birth determines the characteristics you will show in your personality – just as some people believe your astrological signs are present. Saints also schedule certain events throughout the year based on the Tzolk'in calendar. At the beginning of each uinal (20-day period), a med will count forward to determine when religious events and rituals will occur. Then he will choose the days that will be the most prosperous or the luckiest for the community. Despite its my mythical functions, the Tzolk'in calendar still cannot measure a solar year, the time it takes for the sun to perform a complete cycle. Because of this, the Maya need a more accurate calendar to track the time period that we consider to be a full year.
