For some startups, the answer to this dilemma is the creation of an advisory board. According Entrepreneur.com, the Advisory Committee is a small group of business experts who have been selected to help advise the business owner on such issues as marketing, sales, financing, etc. These individuals can guide founders through some obstacles and growing pains in getting the company off the ground. Unlike the, the advisory board is informal and unofficial, and can be structured in any way that is appropriate for your business. Why create an advisory board? Having and leverage a network of consultants can really help you when you build your business, said Jeb Ory, director of phone2Action funding software. Forming an advisory board is a great way to invite industry leaders into a fluid relationship with your company so that they can be sounding boards, provide introductions to future funders and customers, and provide public certification for your business. These advantages can be particularly important for startups that are in the early stages of funding. Bringing experts on the topic can help you ensure that critical business functions are addressed, even if the staff is not quite in place yet. Boards aren't just for high-growth start-ups, though. Ory said that even a small consulting firm or service provider can benefit from an advisory board because getting more perspective and connections can help any entrepreneur to succeed. Sharma said it's best to wait until your concept is completely shut down and you start to see the tow-like ribbons. Who's supposed to make money on the board? When you are ready to build your own committee, which of your contacts and industry leaders should you ask to serve on this? The entrepreneur recommends that you have experts in the legal, accounting, marketing, human resources and financial fields on the board. If you want, you can ask other successful entrepreneurs who understand the basics of business. Ory advised that he should seek diversity when selecting board members. You want to surround yourself with people from different views, he said. It may be tempting to bring big names into your industry, but Ory is careful not to invite people just to the public. If a person approaching for their board can't be booked every hour a month to help, especially in the first to two years of your business, they will be entirely plausible only for PR purposes, he said. How to work with your board When it comes to meeting with members of the Advisory Committee, the entrepreneur's staff wrote that you can combine everything every month or two or meet separately with each counsel. It really depends on the needs of your company, what you're comfortable with and the dynamics you want to develop among consultants, he told the article. It is important to remember that your advisory committee should not offer only occasional advice or serve as a male; they need to add real value, Sharma said. Ory agreed, because good board members are willing to roll up their sleeves and help you succeed. One of the members of our board introduced himself to a partner who is now a key client for the past two years, he told Business News Daily. That's the kind of support you need to grow a business. Finally, Ory said that board members should push and challenge you to evaluate the issues in a different way. [The committees] should be helpful, but also in managing the challenges, Sharma added. A committee that agrees with you all the time doesn't necessarily have to drive the best value, so look for members who... have the discipline and power to make real changes if necessary.

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
