About 93% of people in the U.S. with kidney failure get help from the Medicare End-Stage Renal Disease (ESRD) program. Medicare pays 80% of the costs of kidney transplant surgery (yours and a donor's dialysis) and dialysis at home or in a clinic. If you do a home treatment, you don't have to buy the machine. The clinic will lease it to you. Most people have a health plan through work or a Medigap plan that will pay for all or most of the other 20%. Or, you may need to get a private policy through the Affordable Care Act. If you qualify, been Medicaid can help pay for treatment. The start date of Medicare depends on your choice of treatment. This can make a big difference to how much you will have to pay out of pocket. Medicare covers transplant drugs for 3 years. After that, you need a way to pay for them unless you are disabled for a reason other than CKD. But, if you start training for PD, home HD or self-care at the center before the 4th month begins, Medicare may be back dated to the 1st day of its first month of training.
