Attendance at the meeting was limited and it was streamed live on Facebook to the public. Councilmen and Mayor Jared Carr sat at tables to put the necessary amount of space between them. Carr led a statement on the city response to the public health crisis at the end of the meeting. He said the city is following the guidelines from the Center for Disease Control and Department of Health and Human Services for dealing with the new coronavirus. I want to thank all of our health professionals and first responders who ensure we will remain a safe and prosperous community, Carr said. If you haven't, please get your food to go at one of the many local restaurants that go the extra mile to continue their services to our community. Carr said the community will emerge from the crisis stronger than before. With everyone continuing to cooperated, we'll make it happen, he said. Councilmen also addressed the community, thanking city staff members for their efforts to deal with the situation. Council plans to meet again April 13 but will skip the April 2 workshop and possibly the April 27 meeting, Carr said. For more on this story, see Wednesday's LCR.
