With four AA batteries and about two cups of water, you can get almost 7500 cycles. 11. Hoot Cobra Animal Repeller Hoot animal repeller brand offers 24/7 protection against rabbits, deer, squirrels, foxes and birds. You can also use it to repel bears, raccoons, dogs, cats and rodents. This product has a powerful jet stream. You can put it in the ground quickly. In addition, it is designed to connect to any hose with a fast fit compound. Whenever it senses movement, the sprinkler presses and shoots water all over. It is
