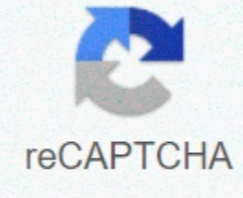

\$ Made with Sketches. You do not need to come to the office to receive a copy of rmc records; however, you must send a written request and \$5.00 to receive a copy. Power of Attorney does not have to be recorded at the RMC office. However, most banks, hospitals, investment firms, etc. require them to be recorded. Recording Power of Attorney documents ensures that if the original is lost, a certified copy is always available. The RMC office records with the owner's name and legal description. If you don't have the owner's name, you can research the property at the Appraising Office on the tax map. By finding the property section on the tax map, the package number can be used to find the owner's name. For building permits located anywhere in the County except in the cities of Aiken and North Augusta, apply to the Department of Planning & Construction (803.642.1518). You must bring two sets of construction plans, and know your tax package number. If you are not going to use a public sewer, a septic tank permit from DHEC is required. Building permits are required for any construction worth \$1,000 or more. A General Contractor License is required for anyone building a non-residential building worth more than \$5,000. To build within the city of Aiken or North Augusta, please contact their building permit office. We have a graph provided to us by the Revenue Department for mileage adjustment. You can contact the Auditor's office by calling 803.642.1510 or emailing auditor@aikencountysc.gov and giving us the mileage and year of your vehicle to find out if you are eligible. The boundaries of the fire district were established by the District Council in 1988. Most areas of the County are served by volunteer firefighters. Contact GIS Mapping Division at 803.642.7592 to see which firefighters are protecting your home. Bring your old car title or registration form to the Auditor's Office. The Auditor's Office will issue you a tax bill, which must be paid at the Treasurer's Office in the same building. Take your paid tax receipt and title or car registration to the SC Motor Vehicle Division at 1755 Richland Avenue East in Aiken or 1711 Ascauga Lake Road in North Augusta to complete registration and get your tag. For questions regarding vehicle registration, call the SC DMV at 800.442.1368 or visit their website at www.scdmv.org. Call the Garbage Buster Hotline at (toll-free) 877.754.8837 to report littering. Call 803.502.STOP to report illegal dumping. License plate transfer is handled through the State Department of Motor Vehicles (SCDMV). A visit to the County Auditor's office is not required while the license plate is being moved. There are certain requirements in ownership and the vehicle whose license plate is diverted from and also the vehicle it will be diverted to. Contact one of the Local SCDMV will be advised prior to their visit. Scdmv's location in Aiken County: Aiken North Augusta Records at the AIKEN County RMC Office dates back to 1872 and is public information. Please contact the Auditor's Office at 803.642.1510. The RMC Office records the original tax lien and meets and/or releases it upon notice from the SC Revenue Department or internal revenue service (IRS). Credit reporting agencies collect information after a lien is recorded, but only rarely do you ever pick up when a lien is satisfied or released. If the tax lien has been satisfied and/or released, you can obtain a copy and send it to the credit reporting agency and request that the lien be removed from your credit report. Please click here for more information on taxes in Aiken County. In South Carolina, you must own a property before you can mortgage it. Most likely, you will receive a copy of the deed when the property is purchased. The mortgage company is responsible for satisfying your mortgage. In 2005, RMC Office implemented a document indexing and imaging system. Deeds and other real estate documents are scanned and available for immediate viewing. The online index starts from 1982 and can be searched and viewed in the eGov section of our website. Aiken County no longer operates public MSW landfills. Construction debris and vegetative debris of the yard (without garbage), and furniture can be taken (07:30 to 17:00 Monday to Saturday) to the Barden C landfill & D is located at 411 Connector Road in Graniteville. The County's Wagener C&D Landfill receives the same type of debris plus dead animals. The Wagener landfill is located at 1769 Wagener Trail Road (Hwy 138) about 7.5 miles southwest of Wagener, and is open Wednesday from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Holiday closures for all drop-off centers and landfills are January 1, Martin Luther King Day, Good Friday, Memorial Day, July 4, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. If you have any questions, contact the Public Works Intensive Waste Division (803.642.1533). According to the SC Forestry Commission website, state law requires that you notify the Forestry Commission before burning outdoors. In most cases, the law applies to burning leaves, limbs and branches that you clean from your yard. Notification laws do not apply within city or city limits, but other local ordinances may apply within those areas; be sure to check with local officials before setting fire. In Aiken County, turn on toll-free 800.895.7057 for a quick way easy to make your yard debris burn notifications. Simply dial the number listen to the message, and leave your name, address, and phone number. The law requires that you clean up the firebreak around the burned site and have the right equipment available to keep the fire under control. Return the form to & Planning; Development for action. For health problems, contact the DHEC Environmental Sanitation Division at 803.642.1637. The road is scraped approximately every six weeks. If your street needs attention, call the Department of Public Works, Division of Roads and Bridges at 803.642.1532. Aiken County no longer operates public MSW landfills. Residents are asked to recycle cardboard, mixed paper (newspapers, junk mail, phone books, magazines, soft cover books, and hard books; No. 1 and 2 plastic bottles, aluminum cans, steel cans, wet cell batteries, used iron and equipment, vegetable oil, used oil, oil filters, oil bottles, and tires. Old mixed fuels can be taken to Belvedere, Langley, or Reynolds Pond Drop-Off Centers and placed in special tanks (red). NO wax paper, vinyl-coated paper, plastic cards, or garbage will be placed in recycling containers. To do so is considered ILLEGAL DUMPING and subject one to a court appearance with the possibility of fines and/or several hours of community service time. Holiday closures for all drop-off centers and landfills are January 1, Martin Luther King Day, Good Friday, Memorial Day, July 4, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. If you have any questions, contact the Public Works Intensive Waste Division (803.642.1533). The Regional Office is open from 08:30 until 17:00, Monday to Friday. The District Office is closed on official holidays - New Year's Day, Martin Luther King's Birthday, Good Friday, Memorial Day, July 4, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and the day after Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve and Christmas Day. Mesne Conveyance Office Register The Register of Mesne Conveyance (RMC) handles all real estate records in Aiken County. All mortgages, deeds, and property plates, amenity, and road rights are recorded in this office. Also noted are South Carolina tax liens, federal tax liens, mechanical liens, and UCC financial statements. Law firms, banks, mortgage companies, or individuals can record documents after recording, the document is scanned and the image is permanently stored in rmc records. This record is public information. RMC RMC Office record military form DD-214. To obtain a copy, you must present a valid identification before the information can be released. Fire costs are assessed by firefighters at all properties located within their fire district. Firefighters don't get tax money from Aiken County to operate firefighters and have to use fire fee money for operational expenses (purchasing equipment, utilities, fuel, firefighting supplies, etc.). Under the terms of the contract with the county, fire costs are assessed in the District's budget ordinance for each fire district, and billed on county property tax bills. If the cost of the fire is not paid at the time the property tax becomes delinquent, many of the firefighters have instructed the County to hand over unpaid fees to the collection agency. Please contact your fire department for more information on the cost of their fire. The appeal must be lodged in writing within 30 days of receiving the notice of judgment. You must file your appeal with the County Appra appraiser. Don't wait until your tax bill arrives to appeal your new value; it's too late then. All records relating to property (deeds, mortgages, plats) are recorded at the RMC Office (803.642.2072) at Suite 2100 of Aiken County Government Center in 1930 University Parkway in Aiken. Copies of deeds can be obtained at a minimal cost. Visit office address 911 (803.642.2054) at ServiceCenter. You have to show it on a map of where your house is located, and where your driveway is out of the way. The Service Center (803.642.7592) has various County maps for sale. The Official County Road Map Atlas, which covers all Federal, State, and County roads (paved and dirt), is also available for sale for \$25, or can be downloaded for free here. Property owners have the right to appeal the new value assigned to their property if, upon receiving their assessment notice, they do not agree with the new value. If you live in one of the cities, contact the city for information on garbage collection. The county does not provide garbage collection in unaccompanied areas of the County. You should call a private company to get the trash picked up at your house. All County residents can use the County Recycling Center to dispose of their household waste. Please click here for more information and the Center is closest to you. That depends on whether the road is a state road, a city road, or a County road. County roads can be identified by black markings at intersections (S-2-xxx). Contact the SC DOT Highway Maintenance Department at 803.641.7665 to request on state roads. If you live in a city and the road is not a country road, contact the city's Department of Public Works. If you live in County and not State Roads, call the County Roads and Bridges Division at 803.642.1532. The county has no control over water providers in the county. Ask you next neighbors to see who the water provider is. Please click here for a list of public water providers in Aiken County.
